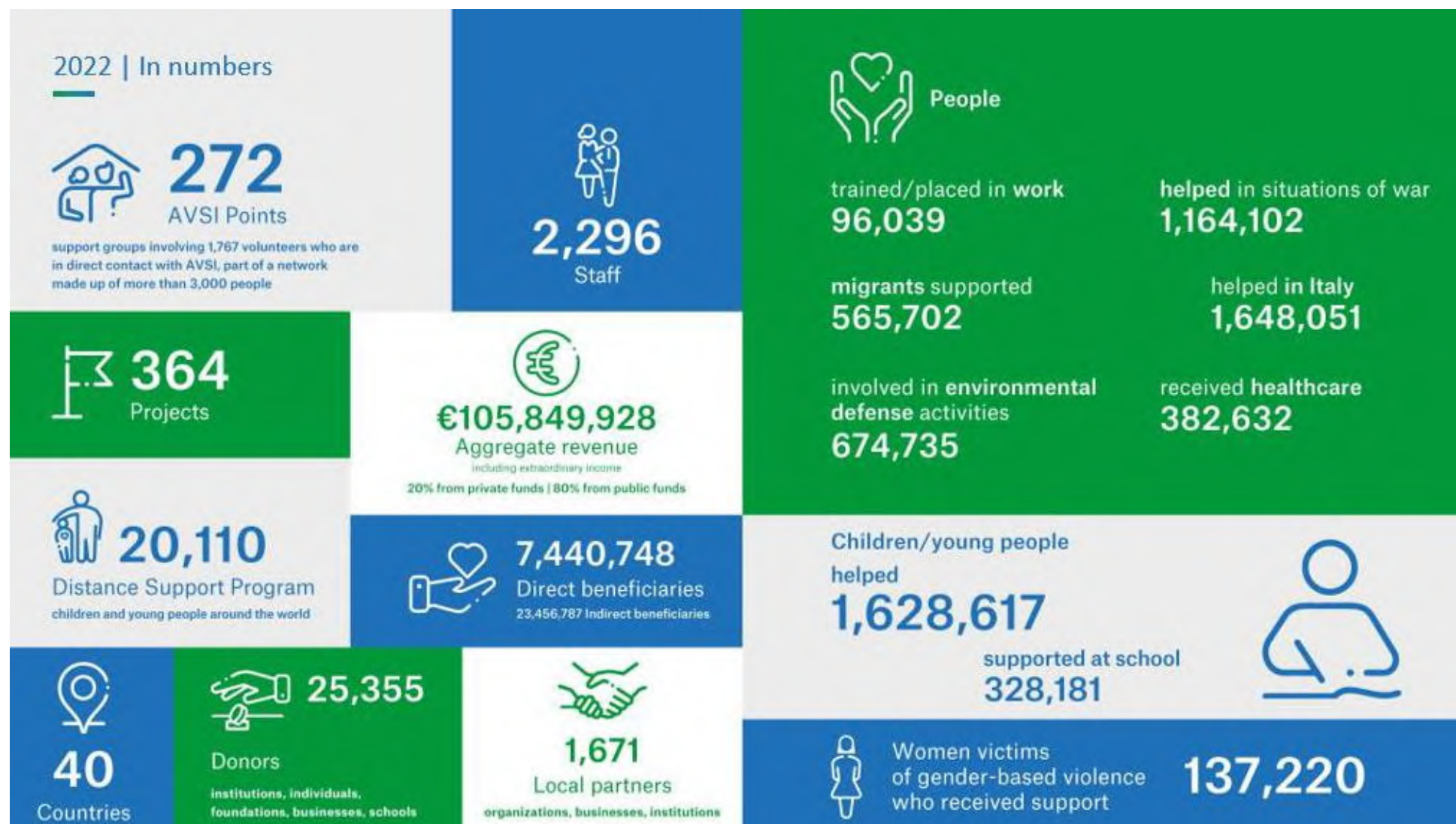

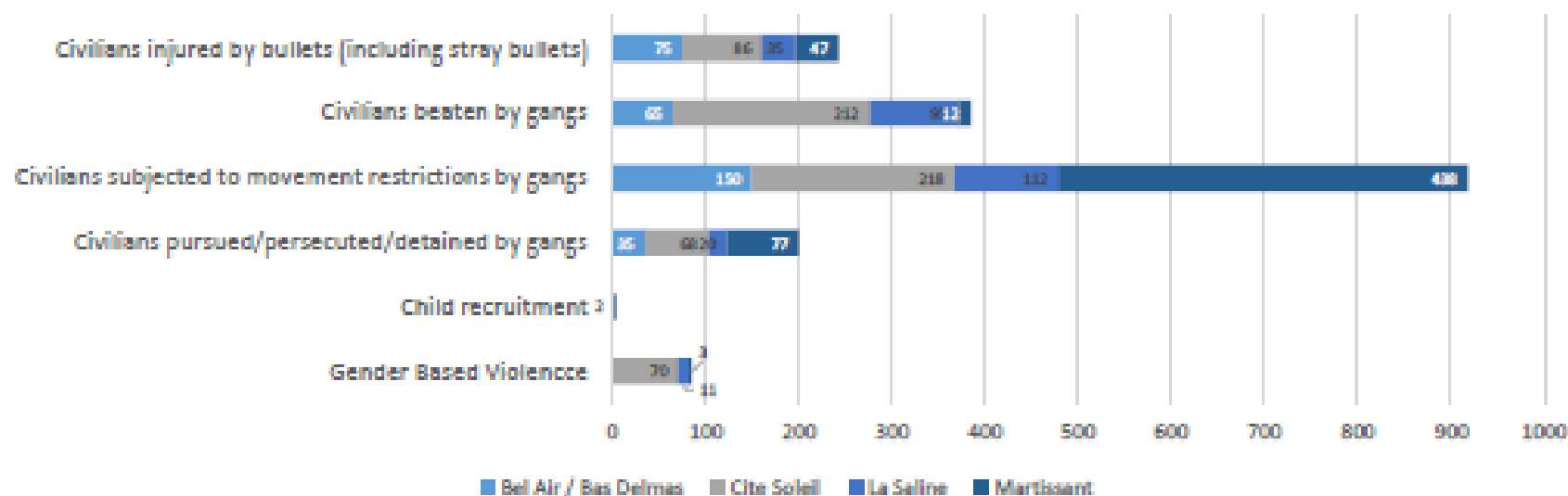

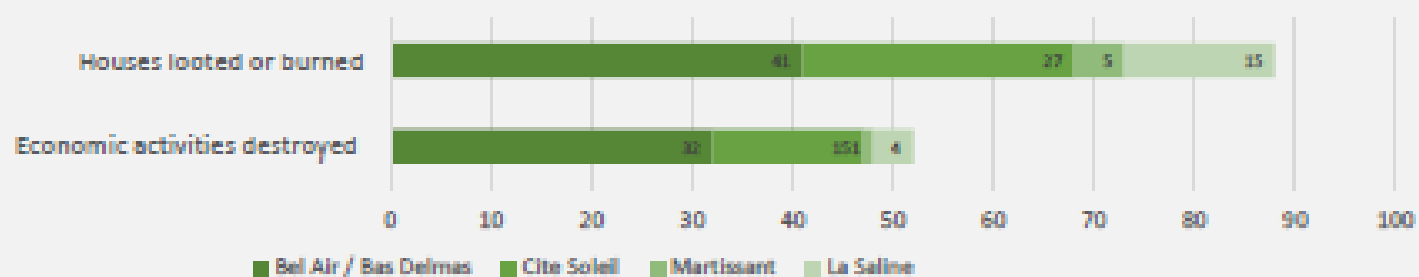

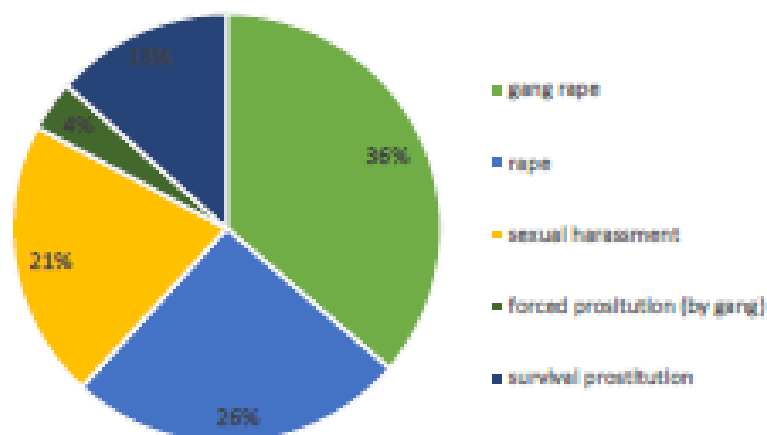


VIOLATIONS AGAINST PROPERTY AFFECTING LIFE CONDITIONS AND SECURITY

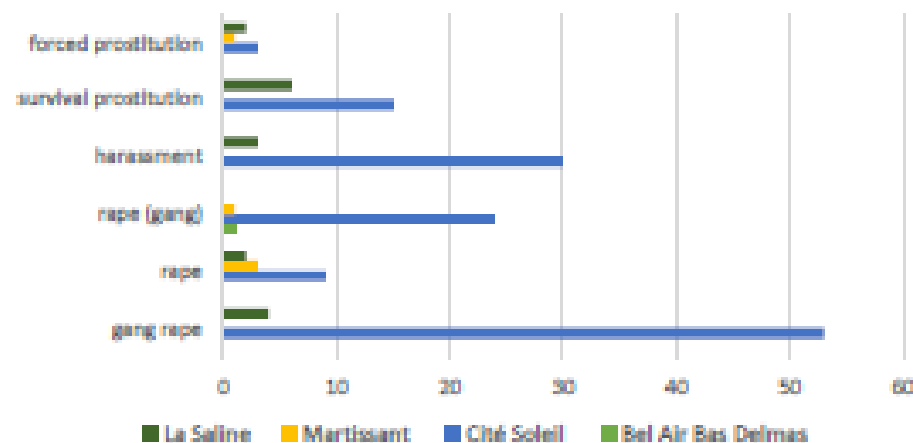


AVSI collection of primary data, sample of 2501 persons (1864 F, 637 M) Average Age: 39 years (minimum age 16, maximum age 89).

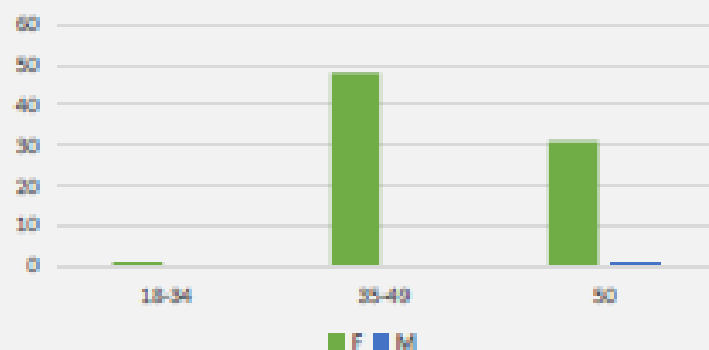
GBV CASE BY TYPE OF VIOLENCE AND SITE



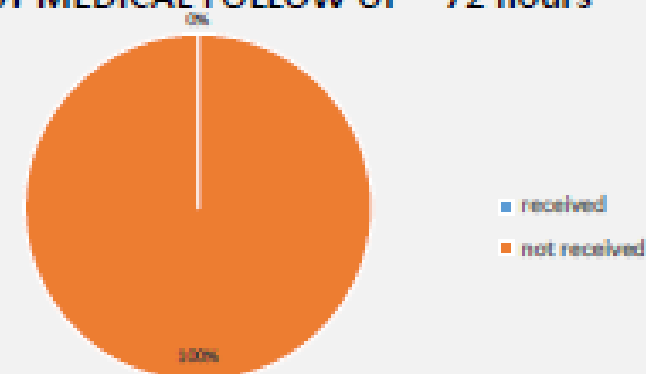
Third quarter 2023, total number of survivors of GBV identified by AVSI is 85 (1 M, 84 female). Source AVSI protection monitoring

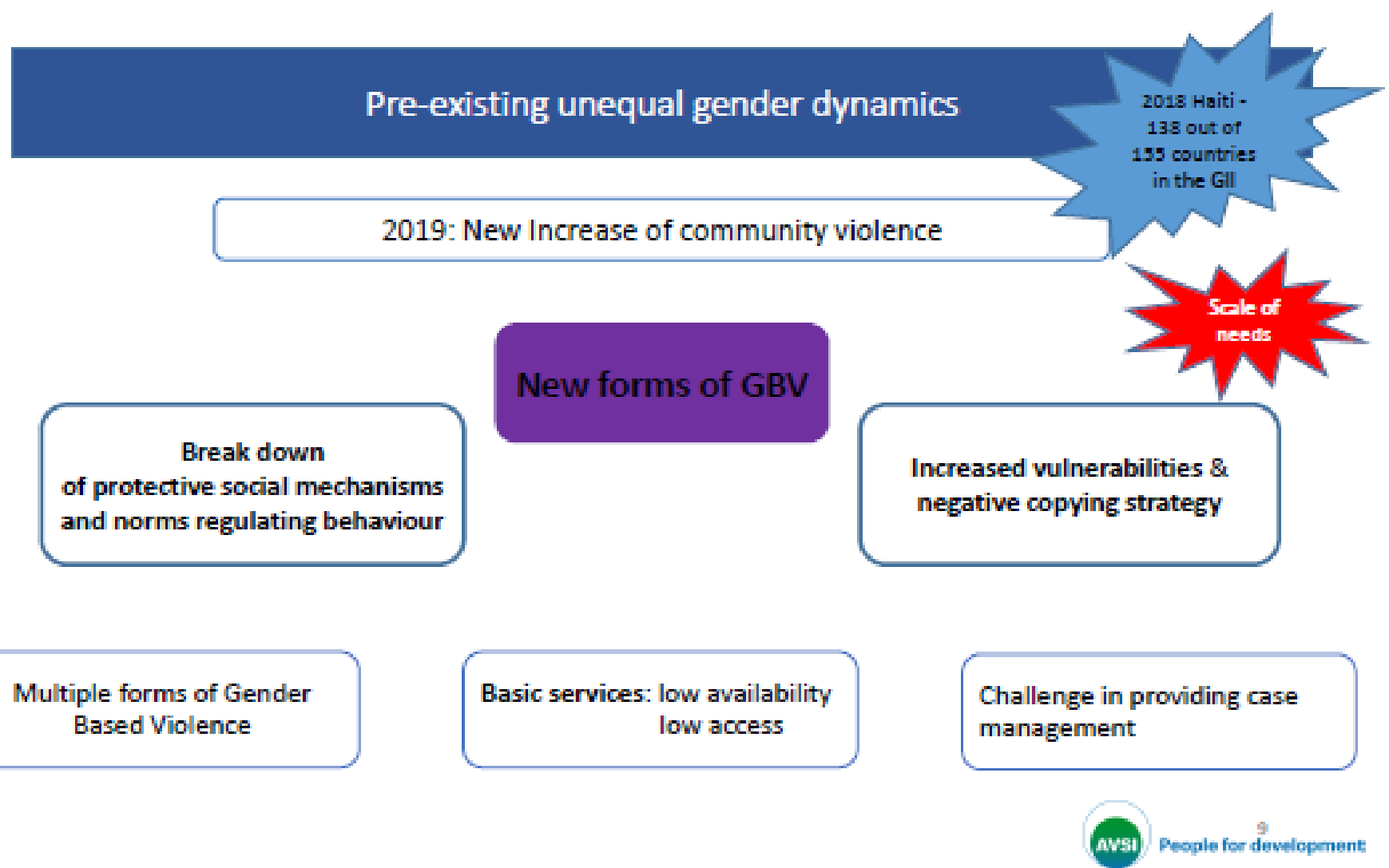


SURVIVORS BY GENDER AND SEX

Education on gender equality –caregivers, adolescents, teachers, local authorities, leaders

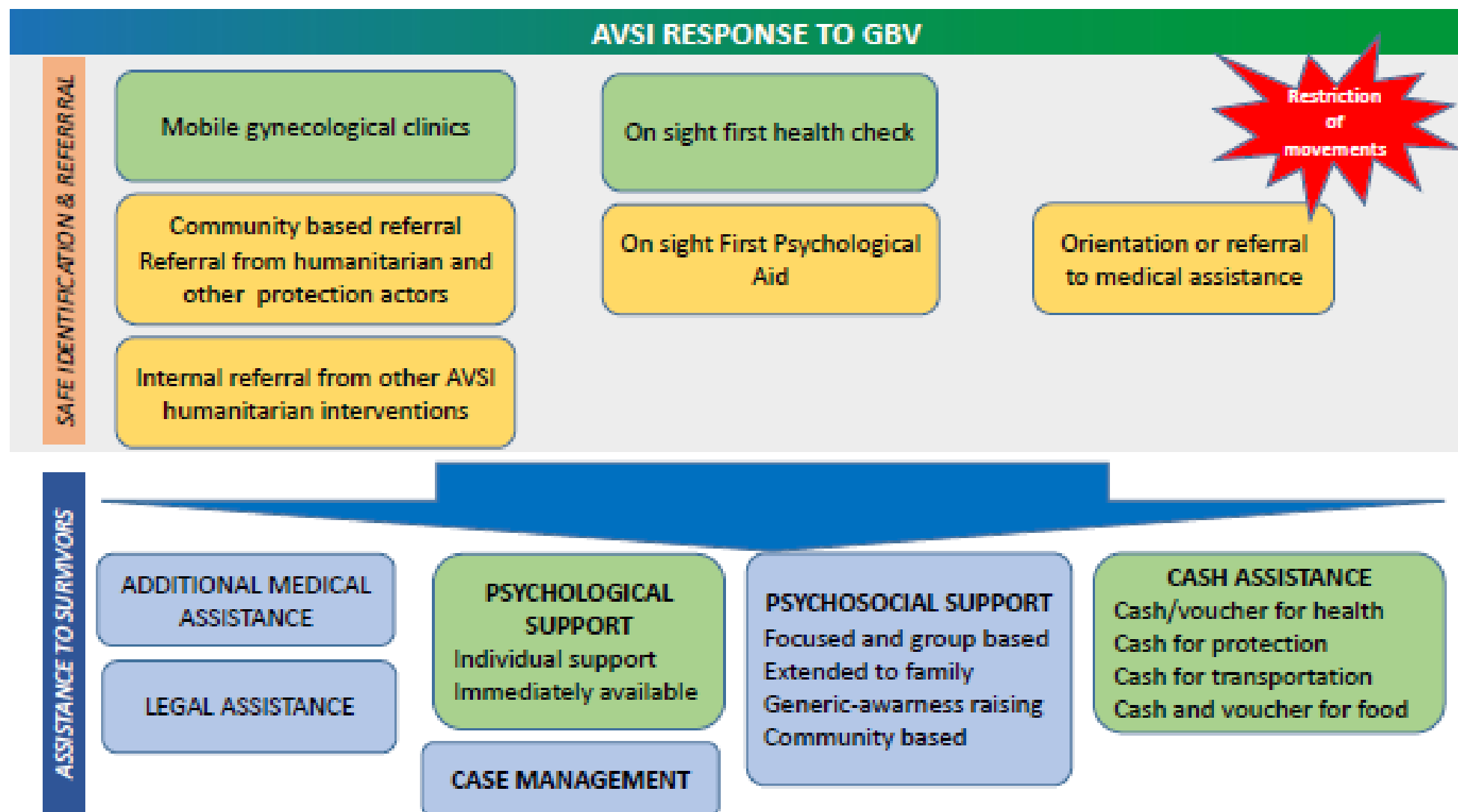
Weekly targeted and non targeted **psychosocial activities** in the community

Recommendations

- Scaling-up activities that relaunch long term gender equality - as per "European Consensus on Humanitarian Aid" –
- Urgently ensure flexible, multiyear, multisectoral, integrated and nexus based funding
- Support interventions providing comprehensive socio-educational pathway, addressing a variety of targets
- Assess the risks of Human Rights Violations and Gender-Based Violence potentially associated with the announced International Security Military Mission
- Ensure immediate attention is directed toward effective prevention of forced recruitment of men and young men
- Prevention, response, prevention!
