As regards the implementation of article 290 TFEU, the Committee agrees to recommend the Council to adopt the unilateral declaration set out in Annex I of document 17477/09, with the following amendment:

- The second paragraph of the draft text should read as follows :

"The Council attaches particular importance to the Commission's commitment to, in the preparatory phase, systematically consult experts from the national authorities of all the Member States, which will be responsible for implementing the delegated acts once they have been adopted. The Council emphasises that the communication constitutes guidelines for the Commission's future exercise of powers delegated under Article 290. The Council notes further that the Commission will carry out the consultations in plenty of time, to give the experts an effective possibility to make a useful and effective contribution."

= **Establishment of the budget of the European Union for 2010**
17467/09 JUR 550 BUDGET 78

The Committee agrees to mandate the Presidency to:

- safeguard the Council's prerogatives as co-author of the legislative act establishing the 2010 EU budget,
- sign the legislative act establishing the budget, together with the President of the European Parliament,
- reserve the right of the Council to make good of its prerogatives before the Court of Justice of the European Union, should the need arise.
