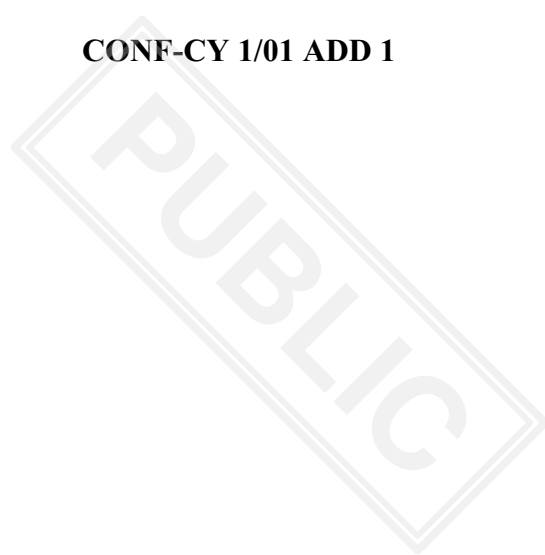

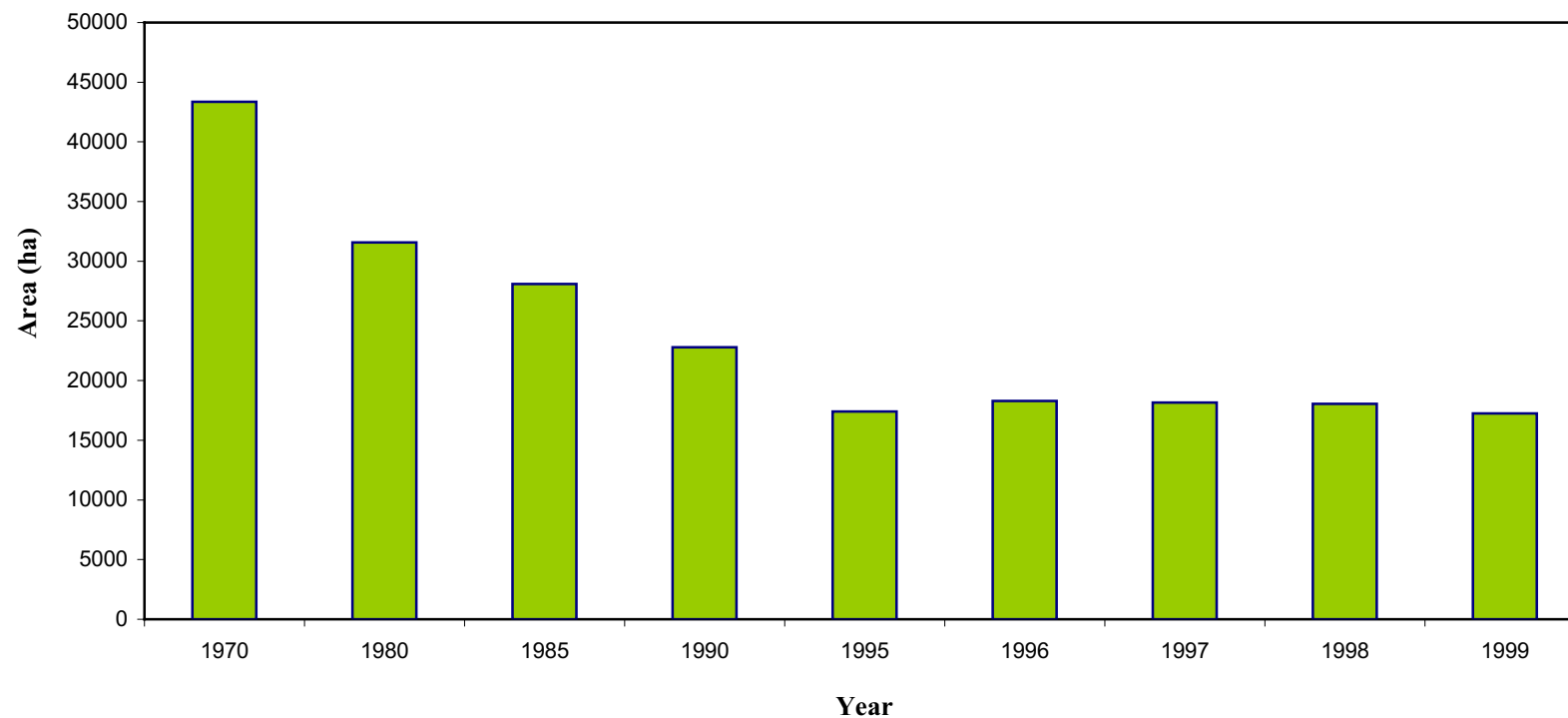

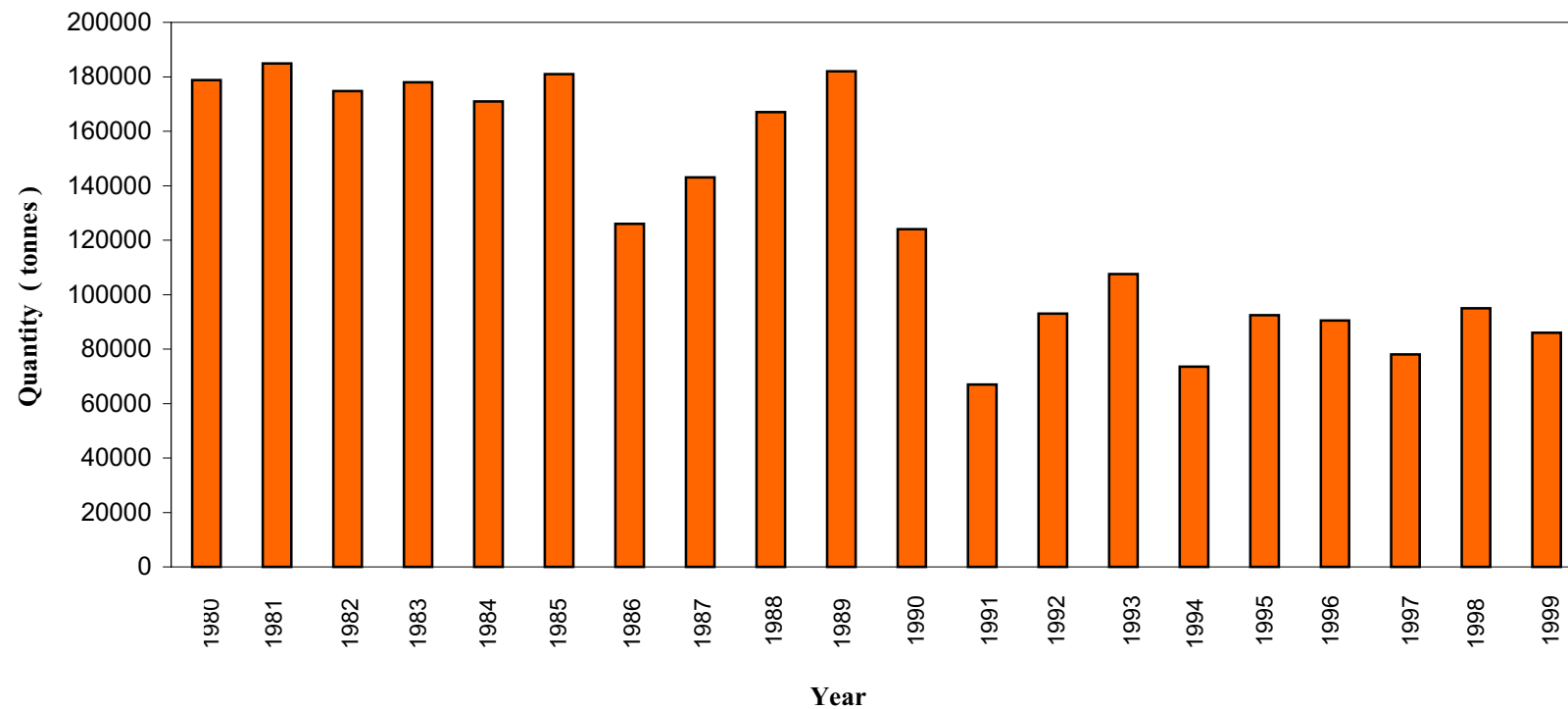

Figure A.1. Evolution of the area under grapes of wine making varieties, 1970 - 1999



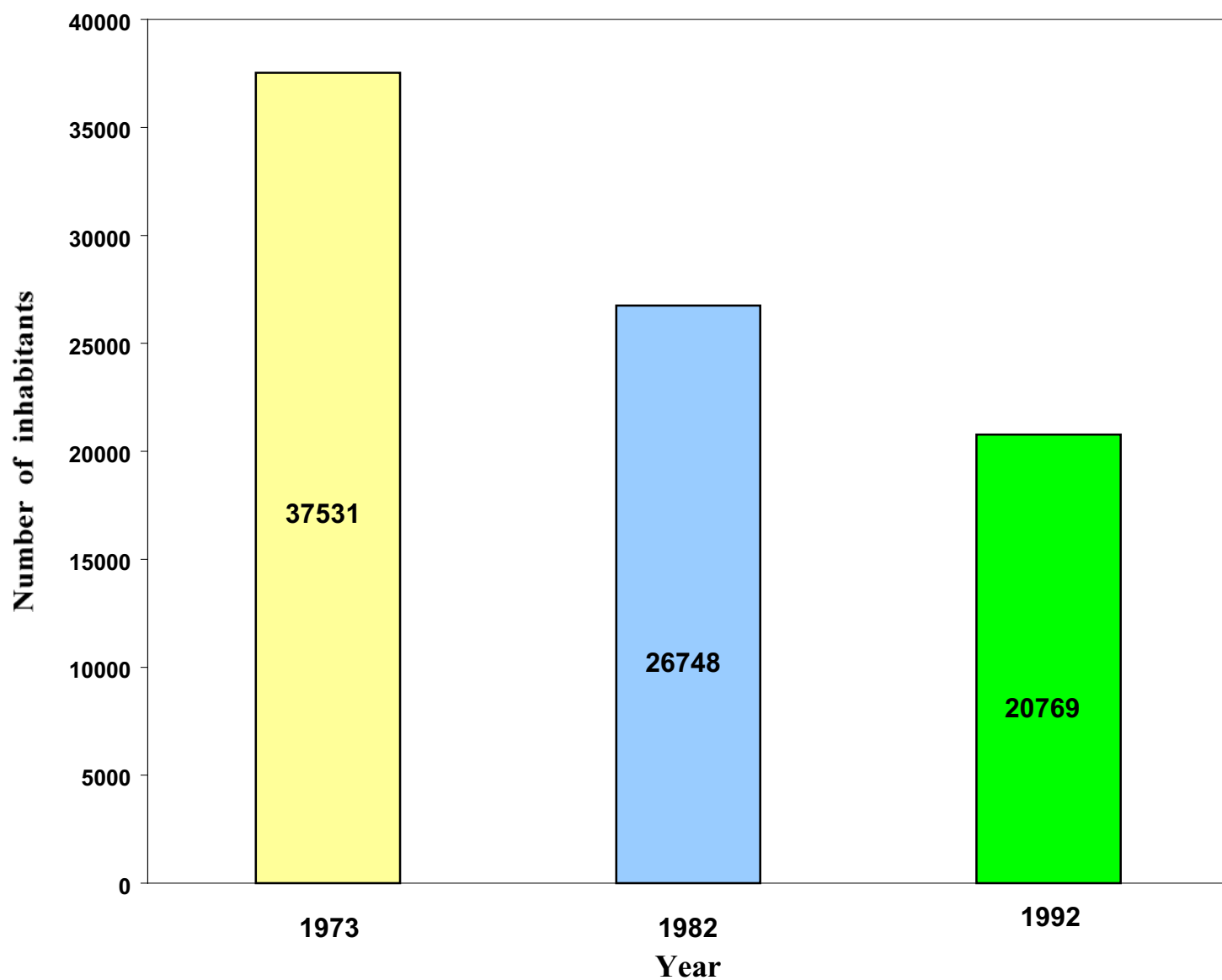

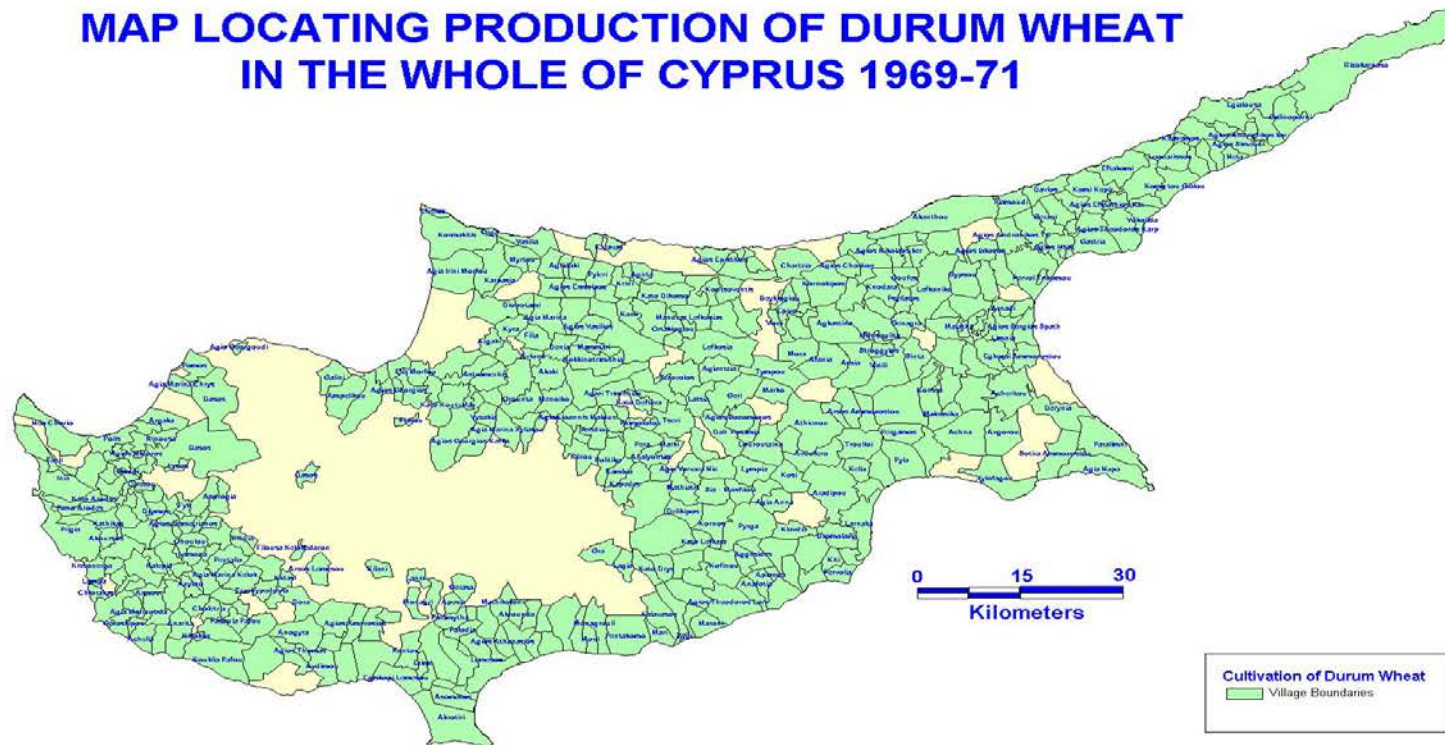
