Having regard to the Partnership Agreement between the members of the African, Caribbean and Pacific Group of States ("the ACP") of the one part, and the European Community and its Member States, of the other part, signed in Cotonou (Benin) on 23 June 2000¹, as revised by the Agreement² amending the said ACP-EC Partnership Agreement, signed in Luxembourg on 25 June 2005, and in particular Article 2 (7) of Annex III thereto,

Whereas:

- 1) Article 9 of the Statutes and Rules of Procedure of the Centre for the Development of Enterprise, adopted by Decision No 8/2005 of the ACP-EC Committee of Ambassadors of 20 July 2005 ¹, provides that the Committee of Ambassadors is to appoint the members of the Executive Board, for a maximum period of five years;
- 2) The term of office of the members of the former Executive Board of the Centre for the Development of Enterprise expired on 9 December 2007 and was not renewed;
- 3) It is therefore necessary to appoint new members of the Executive Board,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:
