Having regard to the Partnership Agreement between the members of the African, Caribbean and Pacific Group of States ("the ACP") of the one part, and the European Community and its Member States, of the other part, signed in Cotonou (Benin) on 23 June 2000¹, as revised by the Agreement² amending the said ACP-EC Partnership Agreement, signed in Luxembourg on 25 June 2005, and in particular Article 3 (5) of Annex III thereto,

Whereas:

- 1) Article 4 of the Statutes and Rules of Procedure of the Technical Centre for Agricultural and Rural Cooperation, adopted by Decision No 4/2006 of the ACP-EC Committee of Ambassadors of 27 September 2006³, provides that the Committee of Ambassadors is to appoint the members of the Executive Board, for a maximum period of five years;
- 2) It is therefore necessary to appoint the members of the Executive Board,
