THE ACP-EC COMMITTEE OF AMBASSADORS,

Having regard to the ACP-EC Partnership Agreement signed in Cotonou on 23 June 2000, and in particular Article 2(7) of Annex III thereto,

Whereas:

1. In Decision No 11/2002 of 10 December 2002 <sup>1</sup>, the ACP-EC Committee of Ambassadors appointed the members of the Executive Board of the Centre for the Development of Enterprise (three EU members and two ACP members, with the third ACP seat left vacant) for a five-year term of office, subject to review after two and a half years.
2. The ACP Group of States has expressed its intention of reconstituting the ACP membership of that Board for the remainder of the current term of office and has nominated three new candidates <sup>2</sup>.
2. It is therefore necessary to appoint the new members of the Executive Board,
