Subject:	Amended Proposal for a regulation of the European Parliament and the Council on the implementation of the Single European Sky (Recast)
	Presidency compromise text on Chapter IV

In view of the Aviation Working Party on 23 February 2023, delegations will find in the Annex the four-column document on Chapter IV of the *Amended Proposal for a regulation on the implementation of the Single European Sky (Recast)*, including Presidency's suggestions or comments in the fourth column.

Deleted text compared with the previous version (document 15119/22) is marked with **red strikethrough**, and new text is marked with **bold**, **italic**, **underline** and the respective cells have an orange background.

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The Presidency wishes to draw delegations' attention to the following lines:

### - line 378

- o several delegations expressed concerns over a possible lack of clarity of the term 'climate-optimised flight trajectories and profiles' and raised concerns over the practical possibilities to incorporate both environmental and climate objectives in the process of optimising flight trajectories; at the same time, the European Parliament considers that climate objectives must be taken into account, in order to meet the general objectives of the Union in reducing the climate impact of aviation;

  The proposed compromise acknowledges these climate objectives and maintains the idea of optimising flight trajectories both from a climate and environmental perspective; furthermore, a recital is proposed to explain that the practical ways to balance the climate and environmental elements will be further developed when designing the performance indicators;
- several delegations asked to include in this paragraph additional safeguards in respect to Member States' sovereignty over their airspace;
   The Presidency is therefore proposing to revert to the wording of the *general approach* in the final part of the text; moreover, the wording in line 423 was further strengthened;

## - line 381

 several delegations asked to exclude the 'optimisation' of airspace structures from the scope of this paragraph and also to delete the reference to the EU-wide performance targets;

Having in mind that the concept of airspace design already incorporates an optimisation element<sup>1</sup>, the Presidency is proposing to delete this term and avoid any redundancies; the wording proposed is 'design and management of airspace structures' which is similar to the wording of the *general approach* in line 379; the reference to 'EU-wide performance targets' was also deleted;

### line 386

several delegations asked to delete the wording 'network operational performance requirements and local reference values' from this line; on the other hand, this is an important point for the European Parliament, as it considers that all relevant stakeholders should comply with 'the network operational performance requirements and local reference values' included in the NOP; it was argued that if one ANSP does not comply with the NOP this has an impact on the activity of other ANSPs and on the overall functioning of the network;

In order to avoid a discussion on the nature of the NOP, the compromise text proposed is using a neutral description of the content of the NOP, as described in Article 9 (2) of Regulation 123/2019<sup>2</sup>;

## line 398

the wording is revised to improve the readability of the provision, as requested by several delegations and in line with the *general approach*;

## line 399

- letter (b) the text is aligned with the wording in line 381, by deleting the references to the 'optimisation' of airspace structures
- letter (c) several delegations asked for the deletion of the text; however, this task of the network manager was already included in the *general approach*; The Presidency is therefore proposing a revised text which includes all the necessary safeguards for Member States, in line with the text of the *general approach* in line 403;
- letter (d) the text is slightly amended to follow the same wording used in line 386;

Regulation 123/2019 - Article 9, paragraph (4): The Network Operations Plan shall include, in particular: (a) network operational performance requirements and local reference values of ATFM delay for the purpose of contributing to the achievement of the Union-wide performance targets; (b) operational actions that contribute... [...].

o letter (i) - several delegations asked for the deletion of the text; however, this task of the network manager was already included in the *general approach*;

The Presidency is therefore proposing a revised text, which clarifies the supporting role of the Network Manager in this area, in line with the wording in the *general approach* in line 408b; Furthermore, the proposed compromise specifically mentions the partnership with operational stakeholders and is further clarified by a recital about the SESAR Deployment and Infrastructure Partnership;

## - line 411

 at the request of several delegations, the Presidency is proposing to postpone the discussions in respect to this element for a later stage;

### - line 413

- several delegations asked to revise this task of the Network Manager, in order to clarify that the remedial measures are only 'proposed' by the Network Manager, while the final decision on their implementation remains with operational stakeholders;
- o The compromise text proposed by the Presidency follows this approach;

## - line 415b

several delegations asked to delete this paragraph, considering that the text as being too prescriptive for Member States; on the other hand, the European Parliament insists on including such a provision, in order to ensure the proper functioning of the cooperative decision-making process of the Network Manager;

As a compromise, the Presidency is proposing a recital to cover this request of the European Parliament.

## - line 423

o further to the changes in line 378, the Presidency is proposing to spell out the 'complete and exclusive competence' of the Member States for the design and management of their airspace structures and of their route network, using a similar wording as the one in line 379 for the *general approach*.

At the Aviation Working Party on 23 February, delegations are invited to express their views/flexibility as regards the above-mentioned provisions and lines.
