Subject:	Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work Appointment of Mr Ferenc NÉDÓ, alternate member for Hungary, in place of Mr Gyula MADARÁSZ, who has resigned

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Mr Gyula MADARÁSZ as alternate member of the above Committee in the governments' representatives category (for Hungary).
2. Under Article 3 of Council Decision of 22 July 2003 setting up an Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work ¹, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

3. In accordance with the usual procedure, the government of Hungary has nominated the following candidate to replace the resigning alternate member for the remainder of the current term of office, ending on 28 February 2025:

- (a) adopt, as an "A" item, the Council Decision replacing an alternate member of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work, and

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Decision of 22 July 2003¹ setting up an Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work, and in particular Article 3 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) By its Decision of 24 February 2022², the Council appointed members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work for the period from 1 March 2022 to 28 February 2025.
- (2) A seat as alternate member in the governments' representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Mr Gyula MADARÁSZ.
- (3) The government of Hungary has nominated a candidate for the vacant seat,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:
