Subject:	Summary of discussions

1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted, as set out in CM 1007/22.

2. Information of the Presidency

The Presidency presented its priorities and working programme for the semester.

3. Financing of terrorism : state of play and next steps

Following presentations by IntCen and Europol, delegations, welcoming the debate, had an exchange of views on the state of play and next steps based on discussion paper 5008/22. Member States were invited to submit written comments by 26 January 2022. The outcome of the discussions could, as appropriate, feed into the ongoing discussions on the AML/CTF-package.

4. Improving the post-hit procedure in the Schengen Information System (SIS) for alerts related to terrorism

Europol presented the state of play of activities of the SIRENE office at Europol, in place since 8 March 2021. Based on the presentation and the questions set out in 5009/22, delegations had an initial exchange of views asking for a number of clarifications in relation to the suggested procedure which should be further addressed. Member States were invited to submit possible written comments by 26 January 2022.

5. Exchanges of analysis : focus on the phenomenon of the independent jihadist threat

Based on discussion paper 5011/22 and following presentations by France, Germany and IntCen, delegations had an exchange of views on the topic. Member States were invited to submit written comments by 4 February 2022.

6. Information on CT and CVE incidents

The Presidency presented the ENFOPOL grid to which eight Member States had contributed.

7. Information on activities related to CT and CVE

The Commission, EEAS, the EU CTC and Europol updated delegations on recent and upcoming CT and CVE-related activities.

8. Any other business

Germany drew the attention to a practitioners' workshop organised by Europol on 19 January 2022.
