THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to the Council Decision of 22 July 2003 setting up an Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 3 thereof,

Having regard to the list of candidates submitted to the Council by the Governments of the Member States

Whereas:

- (1) By its Decision of 12 March 2019<sup>2</sup>, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work for the period from 1 March 2019 until 28 February 2022.
- (2) The members and alternate members remain in office until they are replaced or reappointed.
- (3) Members and alternate members of the Committee should be appointed for a period of three years,
