Royal L-2934 Luxembourg Mr Fernando GOMES Portuguese Minister for the Interior President of the Council Justice and Home Affairs Sir, Following the decision of the Belgian Government to restore its internal border checks temporarily, the Luxembourg Government has in turn decided to make use of the option provided for by Article 2(2) of the Convention implementing the Schengen Agreement and to carry out checks at its borders with neighbouring countries, for a limited period. This decision was taken in order to avoid illegal immigrants who, with the help of facilitators, use our territory as a country of transit, prejudicing public order when refused access to Belgium. Please inform the Member States who are Contracting Parties to the Convention implementing the Schengen Agreement of the content of this letter.
