Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EU) 2016/1011 as regards the exemption of certain third-country spot foreign exchange benchmarks and the designation of replacements for certain benchmarks in cessation, and amending Regulation (EU) No 648/2012 (first reading) - Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption of the legislative act

- On 27 July 2020 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 29 October 2020².
- 3. The European Central Bank delivered its opinion on 18 September 2020³.
- The <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 19 January 2021⁴.
