1.6. Comments

The external borders referred to above are Germany's Schengen external borders.

In August and September 2006 very considerable pressure of illegal migration was recorded at Germany's external borders. In comparison with the corresponding period of the previous year, increases of over 100% were recorded in the number of persons refused entry and apprehended for illegal entry.

Chinese nationals once again ranked top for illegal entry at German airports. In August, a large number of Romanians were also apprehended for illegal entry by air.

Refusal of entry at airports was dominated by Romanians. Markedly lower numbers of persons from the hitherto predominant South American nationalities (Brazil and Bolivia) were recorded in August and September.

That shows an increase of 46,42 % in the number of vessels and of 33,90 % in the number of people, in comparison with the figures for August 2006. In comparison with September 2005 (969 people), this year shows an increase of 696,84 %, so that migration pressure remains very high.

The main countries of nationality were Senegal, Gambia, Mali and Guinea Conakry. The Canary Islands have become the main point of arrival for such vessels.

As regards illegal immigration by sea, in October 2006 a total of 85 vessels, with 2 062 people on board, reached the shores of southern Spain and the Canary Islands. That shows a decrease of 185,86 % in the number of vessels and of 70,99 % in the number of people, in comparison with the figures for September 2006. In comparison with October 2005 (2 040 people), this year shows an increase of 1,07 %.

The main countries of nationality were Senegal, Gambia, Mali and Côte d'Ivoire. The Canary Islands have become the main point of arrival for such vessels.

The Spanish delegation wishes to draw attention to the increase in the number of unaccompanied minors reaching Spanish shores on vessels coming through Spain's external sea borders.

**1.6. Comments**

Summarizing results of October 2006 in comparison with the previous month the number of refusals of entry has increased by 29,63 % and increased by 64,03 % compared to October 2005. The highest number of refusals relates to citizens of Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Kyrgyzstan and Armenia. Most refusals were carried out at the land borders of Russia and Belarus.

In October on the border crossing points at the Latvia-Lithuania and Latvia – Belarus borders were voided visas for 18 persons – 9 Armenia, 3, Russia, 2 Ukraine, 2 Belarus, 2 Tajikistan who could not ground the purpose for entry into Latvia. Their luggage testified that the purpose is illegal work in some of the European Union states or correlations of work in Latvian enterprises ended.

Concerning apprehended aliens inside the country there has been a decrease by 43,48 % in comparison with the previous month (September – 23 persons: October – 13 persons) and a decrease by 23,53 % compared to October 2005. Expulsions have increased by 14,29 % in comparison with the previous month (September – 7 persons: – October 8 persons) and have decreased by 11,11 % compared to October 2005. In October on the border crossing points a number of detected persons with false documents have increased by 150 % (September – 4 persons: October- 10 persons).

Apprehended in border regions:

Nationals of the Russian Federation reach Austria almost exclusively via the route followed in the previous year, from Slovakia, generally crossing the green border or blue border on foot.

Operational intelligence - action taken:

It is not known at present which migrants of Chechen nationality actually come from the crisis region of Chechnya. The majority of these migrants probably no longer come from that region, however.

**Moldova:**

General:

The marked fall in September was followed by a renewed increase, with 131 smuggled Moldovan nationals apprehended. A clear reduction is nonetheless apparent compared with October 2005, when 211 were apprehended.

Some 86 % of Moldovan nationals are apprehended at border crossings.

Reasons for migration:

No change compared with the previous months. Purely economic reasons (high unemployment, low incomes) leading to the attempt to find work in EU countries. In this connection Austria can be regarded essentially as a transit country.

By land, predominantly from Slovakia. From there by foot across the green and blue borders or hidden in goods trains travelling to Austria, bound for Italy or other Schengen states. A not inconsiderable proportion enter Slovakia legally with a Slovak (tourist/tour group) visa. In recent weeks a new modus operandi has been identified in the form of large-scale smuggling using lorries, together with Ukrainian nationals.

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## **AUSTRIA**

### **Serbia and Montenegro:**

#### **General:**

Although there was a very slight increase compared to September, the number of persons apprehended having been smuggled from the area of the former Serbia and Montenegro is continuing to fall, even when the separation of Serbia and Montenegro is taken into account.

#### **Apprehended in border regions:**

Only about 18% of Serbian/Montenegrin nationals are apprehended at border crossings.

#### **Routes:**

The routes remain unchanged. On the one hand, facilitation takes place from Hungary, primarily from the region of the border between Hungary and Burgenland; on the other, facilitation via Slovenia to Austria has been in evidence, as in the previous month. In one case, at the end of October, a large-scale smuggling operation from Croatia via Slovenia to Austria, and then on to Italy, was detected. The Federal Criminal Police Office is investigating the case.

#### **Method:**

There is no significant new feature in evidence, month to month, in the method used for smuggling. Based on the information currently available, the persons smuggled are conveyed, concealed or across the green border, using other persons' EU identity documents.

In the reporting period 87 falsified or counterfeit documents were discovered at border-crossings. Among them were border control stamps – 28, passports – 18, driving licences – 18 and identity cards – 6.

The most misused documents by country of origin were Slovenian – 19, Italian -10, Romanian - 9, Austrian - 8.

The most misused documents by type were: Slovene border control stamp – 16, Austrian border control stamp – 7, Romanian licence for goods traffic – 4 and Czech driving licence - 4

The majority of all documents were seized on the future EU external border with Croatia – 64 (73.56 % of all documents).

1.6. Comments

**In September 2006**, refusals of entry decreased by 48 % in comparison with the same period in 2005. The leading nationality was Ukrainian which is understandable as this is the only adjacent third country.

In the area of illegal migration to Slovak Republic, is constant situation as in comparison with September 2005. In September 2006, illegal migration pressure in comparison with September 2005 decreased by 14 %. The leading nationality of illegal migrants was Moldovian, in comparison with September 2005 was Russian.

The number of asylum seekers decreased by 68 % in comparison with the same period 2005. Nationalities of asylum seekers figured the same in comparison with the same period 2005.

**In October 2006**, refusals of entry decreased by 252 % in comparison with the same period in 2005. The leading nationality was Ukrainian which is understandable as this is the only adjacent third country.

In the area of illegal migration to Slovak republic, there is a decreasing tendency by 83 % in comparison with October 2005. In October 2006, illegal migration pressure in comparison with September 2006 decreased by – 18 %.

Number of asylum seekers decreased by 51 % in comparison with the same period 2005.

The decreasing tendency in expulsion is directly connected with the decreasing tendency of illegal migration through the territory of Slovakia in the previous year.

**1.6. Comments**

Statistics continue to show that Chinese nationals dominate the table in relation to the number of asylum applications submitted at the UK frontier, increasing by 25 and 17.4 per cent in comparison to September and October 2005. Eritrean nationals have replaced Afghan nationals during September and October in relation to asylum claims within the UK borders despite an increase in October. The number of Brazilian nationals refused entry at the frontier fluctuated during September and October although despite this they continue to be placed first in the table. Nigerians continue to account for the highest number of forged documents submitted on arrival.

Vietnam: With a total of 15 applications for asylum by October, Vietnam is the 43<sup>rd</sup> largest asylum application country in 2006. In the same period in 2005 Norway received 17 applications from citizens of Vietnam.

## **1.6. Comments**

In the reporting period (1 September - 31 October 2006) the number of refused aliens was 959, which was by 18 % less compared to the same period of 2005. Top five of refused aliens remained stable in terms of nationality.

The main reasons for refusal were as follows: without visas – 929 (Turkey – 187, Bosnia – 28, Russia – 26 and Ukraine - 24); improperly documented motor vehicles – 96; expired travel documents – 63, etc.

In the field of asylum the reporting period saw an increase in the number of asylum applications submitted both at the frontier and within the national territory. There is a stable tendency of having the largest number of asylum applicants from Afghanistan, part of them being minors and unaccompanied. Untypical asylum seekers appeared from Congo, Vietnam and Georgia but their number was insignificant. Many of the asylum applicants establish contacts with smugglers, who organize their facilitation to Western Europe.

## **Arrangements on entry and residence of foreign nationals in the Republic of Bulgaria**

- ❖ Bilateral agreements for mutual travel of citizens were signed with FYROM (3 November 2006), Republic of Montenegro (10 November 2006) and Republic of Serbia (13 November 2006). The agreements introduce visa regime for the nationals of those states and enter into force on 1 January 2007.
- ❖ Visa free regime was introduced for the nationals of another seven states from the positive visa list (Annex II of EC/539/2001), namely Guatemala, Nicaragua, Salvador, Honduras, Costa Rica, Mexico and Panama by a Council of Ministers' Decision No. 590 of 4 August 2006.

Furthermore, under the above decision visas shall not be required for a period of 90 days within 6 months from the date of first entry from the nationals of Australia, UK, Canada, New Zealand, Ireland and the USA, who possess valid ordinary passports.

The Decision has been in force since 1 September 2006.

- ❖ By a Council of Ministers' Decision No. 725 of 20 October 2006 concerning entry and exit of EU nationals to/from the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria, nationals of the EU, EEA and EFTA can enter, stay and transit through Bulgaria **with valid ID cards** for a period of 90 days within 6 months from the date of first entry. The Decision has been in force since 27 October 2006, two months before effective membership of Bulgaria to the EU.

**1.6. Comments**

The nationals of the Republic of Moldova represent 73 % out of the total number of the aliens refused entry. They are followed at a great distance by the nationals of Ukraine (16 %) and Bulgaria (1 %). A short increase was noticed, comparing to the previous month.

Almost 50 % of the illegal aliens apprehended were the nationals of the Republic of Moldova and Turkey.

Regarding the requests for asylum within the national territory, there were 24 cases during the period under consideration. Most of the people who applied for asylum were the Afghani (7), Iraqi (5).

It was a decrease in the number of expulsions in comparison to August 2006 and a small decrease in relation to the same month in 2005.

1.6. Comments

There was a downward trend (-6 % respectively -9 %) in the number of refusals of entry in October 2006. The main nationalities were the Moldavian and the Ukrainian.

Regarding the illegal aliens apprehended, also a small decrease was noticed in relation to the previous month (-20 %) and to October 2005.

During the period under consideration there were 36 applications for asylum most of the cases coming from the Turkish and the Somali nationals.

The number of expulsions went down by 56 % in October 2006; more than 65 % out of the total number were the Moldavian nationals.

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
