## UNITED NATIONS ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR EUROPE TECHNICAL COOPERATION PROJECT FORM

Project title: Servicing the negotiations of a legally binding agreement on forests hosted by UNECE Expected timing/duration: March 2020 - December 2021 Objective and brief summary of the project: Forests play an active role in the sustainable development and well-being of societies. There is currently no comprehensive legally binding instrument on forests. Ministers responsible for forests in Europe decided to establish a regional process including an Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee (INC). The mandate for negotiations for a legally binding agreement on Forests in Europe was signed at the Sixth Ministerial Conference on the Protection of Forests in Europe that was organized by Forest Europe (June 2011, Oslo, Norway). The negotiations of the text stalled, and no final consensus could be found by the Extraordinary Ministerial Conference (Madrid, 21 October 2015). Through a Ministerial Decision dated 6 December 2018, signatories of the Forest Europe invited the UNECE, to convene, together and servicing jointly with FAO, further negotiations on a legally binding agreement on forests in Europe by setting up a negotiating process in an appropriate format based on the parameters contained in this decision ("invite the UNECE, with the support of FAO to convene and service jointly further negotiations on a legally binding agreement on forests in Europe by setting up a negotiating process in an appropriate format based on the parameters contained in this decision"). Due to its joint nature, the UNECE/FAO Forestry and Timber Section is best placed to start negotiations on a legally binding agreement on forests in the European sub-region. The objective of this project is to facilitate negotiations on a Legally Binding Agreement on Forests in Europe. This project will enable the secretariat to have sufficient resources available to service the process without relying on regular budget resources. This objective will be achieved by implementing the following activities: A1.1. Organisation of 3 meetings to negotiate a legally binding agreement on forests in Europe; A1.2. Providing legal advice to the UNECE member States on the legally binding agreement on forests; A1.3. Editing and translation of official documents (including annotated agenda, meeting documents and reports from the three meetings as well as upon agreement reached, editing and translation of official outcome of the negotiations (Legally Binding Agreement). Special Note to EXCOM: The proposed project is exceptionally submitted for consideration to the 109th Session of the EXCOM, pending the outcome of EXCOM's deliberation on the Agenda item XX. Expected results of the project: EA1. Strengthened cooperation of UNECE member States on sustainable forest management in the UNECE region Target group and beneficiaries of the project: Beneficiaries are the UNECE member States. The main target group is ministerial-level policy makers or advisors to policy makers on matters related to forests, and foreign affairs. Justification of project and its relationship to the programme of work: The proposed project is directly linked to the objective of the Subprogramme 7 "Forestry and Timber" "to strengthen sustainable management of forests and enhance the contribution of forests and forest products to sustainable development in the ECE region" of the UNECE programme budget for 2020.
