Case C-771/23 Poland v Parliament and Council

Action for annulment of Directive (EU) 2023/1791 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 September 2023 on energy efficiency and amending Regulation (EU) 2023/955 (recast)

## DOCUMENT PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC (07.02.2024)

- 1. By an application notified to the Council on 25 December 2023, the Republic of Poland has brought an action, pursuant to Article 263 TFEU, for the annulment of Directive (EU) 2023/1791 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 September 2023 on energy efficiency and amending Regulation (EU) 2023/955 (recast).
- 2. In support of its application, the applicant submits two pleas:
  - incorrect legal basis, as the Directive should have been based on Article 192(2), c)
     TFEU;
  - breach of the principle of proportionality.
- 3. As one of the defendants, the Council is required, under Article 124(1) of the Rules of Procedure of the Court of Justice, to lodge a defence within two months of the notification of the application.
