The figures for refusal of admission remained relatively stable in the summer months of June, July and August. There was an average decrease of almost 50 % on the previous year, which is attributable, inter alia, to the temporary introduction of border controls in connection with the FIFA 2006 championship in Germany.

There was a slight increase in the cases of unlawful entry detected during the summer months. The main contributory factor to this was nationals of China, Serbia and finally also of Iraq. At airports it was particularly the Chinese who had the lead in the statistics for unlawful entry over the three months as a whole.

In the field of asylum, a distinct increase in the number of applications was noted as from July. Iraqi and Vietnamese applicants played a leading part in that increase. Iraqi nationals accounted for over a third of all asylum applications in August in Germany.

From all persons who were refused at the border crossing points 145 persons (June -135 persons) were refused to enter Latvia because could not present the valid visa of the Republic of Latvia. The figures of refusals instantly rose in July 2007 as compared to the figures of June 2007 especially on the land borders. The Ukrainian, the Austrian and the Serbian border sections were the most active ones with respect to refusals in the analyzed period as these have been the most active for years. The main refused nationalities were Romanian, Ukrainian and Serbian nationals. The increase of Romanian nationals shows an interesting tendency. 1.6. Comments

In **July 2007**, refusals of entry decreased by 64 % in comparison with the same period in July 2006. Ukrainians remain the main nationality being refused entry at Slovak Borders, with 82 persons being refused.

In the area of illegal migration to the Slovak Republic, there is a decreasing tendency as in comparison with July 2006, there is 25 % decrease. The leading nationalities of illegal migrants was Moldovan and Pakistani.

1.6. Comments

The number of refused aliens went down by 10 %, compared to the previous month; compared to August 2006 the number went down by 60 %. Ukrainian nationals constitute the most numerous group of refused aliens (73 %).

Main reasons for refusal were travelling without valid visa (UKR), without necessary financial resources or undocumented travelling (SYR).

In August 2007, 268 foreigners were apprehended. The number of illegal aliens apprehended in comparison with July 2007 decreased by 23 %. The leading nationalities of illegal migrants were Moldavians, Georgians and Pakistanis.

In the reporting period the Slovak Republic had 324 asylum applicants. The figures of registered asylum applications increased by 42 % compared to the month of July 2007, the most numerous groups remained Pakistanis (94 persons) and Indians (73 persons).

The number of expulsions carried out has slightly decreased by 7 %, in relation to the previous month. The tendency of having the largest number of removed aliens coming from Ukraine remains unchanged. During the month of August 2007 Ukrainians comprised 74,5 % of aliens expelled from the Slovak territory.
