### Trešais progressa ziņojums par normatīvās vides vienkāršošanas stratēģiju

#### 1. IEVADS

Pēdējo piecdesmit gadu laikā Eiropas Savienība ir izstrādājusi apjomīgu tiesību aktu kopumu (*acquis*), reaģējot uz pilsoņu, uzņēmumu un publisko iestāžu vajadzībām. Tā ir piešķirusi pilsoņiem jaunas tiesības, atvērusi tirgu uzņēmumiem, apkopojusi publiskās intereses un tādējādi veicinājusi izaugsmi un labklājību. Tomēr tiesību akti var arī radīt izdevumus. Tāpēc svarīgākais uzdevums ir rast pareizo līdzsvaru arī ilgākam periodam un mainīgos apstākļos.

Tādēļ tagadējā Komisija savu pilnvaru sākumā pauda ciešu apņemšanos pārskatīt *acquis*, nodrošinot spēkā esošo tiesību aktu piemērotību, efektivitāti un proporcionalitāti<sup>1</sup>. Normatīvās vides vienkāršošanas stratēģija<sup>2</sup> un paralēli izstrādātā programma administratīvā sloga mazināšanai tiecas atjaunināt, modernizēt un vienkāršot ES normatīvo vidi. Pēc četriem gadiem jau ir redzami pārliecinoši šo pasākumi rezultāti. Vienkāršošana, kas bija nesaistītu pasākumu kopums, tagad kļuvusi par veidu, kā saskaņoti pārskatīt politiku, aptverot visas tās jomas. Šo virzību padara uzskatāmu *acquis* izskatīšana, kuras rezultāti publicēti paralēli šim ziņojumam.

Trešais progressa ziņojums par normatīvās vides vienkāršošanas stratēģiju papildina Trešo labāka regulējuma stratēģisko pārskatu Eiropas Savienībā<sup>3</sup> un Komisijas darba dokumentu par administratīvā sloga samazināšanu. Tajā aplūkoti ievērojami sasniegumi kopš stratēģijas sākuma, izcelti veiksmīgi piemēri un iezīmētas jomas, kurās jānotiek vienkāršošanai.

## 2. PAŠREIZĒJAIS STĀVOKLIS

Komisija ar visdažādāko apspriešanas mehānismu palīdzību nepārtraukti vāc un analizē pilsoņu, ieinteresēto personu un dalībvalstu ierosinājumus, kā pieņemt skaidrākus, vienkāršākus un iedarbīgākus Kopienas tiesību aktus.

Komisija, balstoties uz šo ieguldījumu, izstrādāja „vienkāršošanas caurviju programmu”, kurā iekļautas 100 vienkāršošanas iniciatīvas 2005.–2008. gada periodam. Programmā tiek izmantots pilnīgs, vienkāršošanas stratēģijā apzinātu instrumentu kopums. Te var minēt likumdošanas paņēmienus, un proti, atcelšana, kodificēšana un pārstrādāšana, kā arī citus *acquis* modernizācijas līdzekļus, piemēram, plašāks IT risinājumu pielietojums.

Kopš 2007. gada vienkāršošanas programma ir integrēta Komisijas Likumdošanas un darba programmā. Katru gadu to papildināja ar jaunām iniciatīvām, un tagad tā aptver visas politikas jomas. Pašlaik programmā ir 185 iniciatīvas, no kurām Komisija ir jau pieņēmusi apmēram 132, 2007. un 2008. gadā sasniedzot aptuveni 80 % augstu izpildes rādītāju. Tas nozīmē, ka Komisija ir apņēmusies pārvarēt visus šķēršļus un sniegt priekšrocības, savlaicīgi īstenojot šīs prioritātes.

Vienkāršošanas programmā (2005–2009) Komisija jau ierosināja grozīt vai atcelt aptuveni 800 tiesību aktus. Kad *acquis* būs pieņemts, tas būs samazināts par teju 600 tiesību aktiem jeb 6500 lappusēm *Oficiālajā Vēstnesī*. Tomēr tiesību aktu vienkāršošana ir tālejošāka. Tā ir kļuvusi par neatņemamu visa veida politikas pārskatīšanas sastāvdaļu. Līdztekus Komisija turpināja *acquis* kodificēšanu, lai, nodrošinot tiesisko noteiktību, tiesību akti būtu kompaktāki un viegli lasāmi. Komisija jau ir pabeigusi 229 tiesību aktu kodificēšanu. Likumdevēji jau pieņēma 142 no tiem un aizstāja ar tiem 729 iepriekšējos dokumentus, kas atbilst aptuveni 1300 lappusēm *Oficiālajā Vēstnesī*.

Tagadējā Komisija šo darbību sāka 2005. gadā, un kopumā *acquis* tiks samazināts par gandrīz 10 % jeb teju 1300 tiesību aktiem un 7800 lappusēm *Oficiālajā Vēstnesī*.

## 3. REZULTĀTI

Pagaidām likumdošanas process noslēdzies apmēram 75 no pieminētajām 132 vienkāršošanas iniciatīvām; tostarp ir 36 Komisijas autonomie tiesību akti (4. pielikums) un 39 tiesību akti, kurus pieņēmis likumdevējs (5. pielikums).

Minētie un citi vienkāršošanas pasākumi rada acīmredzamus ieguvumus uzņēmumiem, pilsoņiem un valsts iestādēm. Turpmākajās iedaļās sniegti vairāki piemēri, kuros redzamas dažādas papildinošanas vienkāršošanas pieejas.

### 3.1. Racionāls regulējums

Tiesību aktu kopuma uzbūve veidojas laika gaitā, kad sākotnējiem tiesību aktiem pievieno jaunus elementus. Lai nodrošinātu, ka spēkā esošie tiesību akti ir saderībā un nav pretrunā, Komisija tos nemitīgi pārskata, meklējot efektīvākus un rezultatīvākus leģislatīvos risinājumus.

- Jaunā **vispārējā grupu atbrīvojuma regula** atļauj dalībvalstīm apstiprināt vairākus atbalsta pasākumus, Komisiju iepriekš neinformējot, un ātrāk izskatīt atsevišķos gadījumus. Regulas mērķis ir veicināt nodarbinātību un konkurētspēju, un tā aptver atbalstu MVU, pētniecībai, inovācijai, reģionālajai attīstībai, mācībām, nodarbinātībai un

riska kapitālam. Piemēram, uzņēmumi var saņemt atbalstu fundamentāliem pētījumiem (līdz 100 %), rūpnieciskajiem pētījumiem (līdz 50/70%) un eksperimentālajai izstrādei (25/45%). Regula vienā dokumentā arīdza saskaņo un konsolidē piecus tiesību aktus.

- Jaunie noteikumi par **zemniekiem piešķirto tiešo maksājumu** kontroli nodrošina vienkāršāku un efektīvāku veidu, kā veikt kontroles atļaujas, plānot kontroles grafiku un procedūras pārbaudēm klātienē<sup>4</sup>.
- Jaunā regula par **uzņēmējdarbības strukturālo statistiku** samazina nepieciešamās informācijas apjomu un paredz datu vākšanu pa vienu nevis vairākiem gadiem. Līdztekus tika izveidota jaunā ekonomisko darbību statistiskā klasifikācija Eiropas Kopienā. Sagaidāms, ka ziņojamo datu apjoms kopējais samazinājums būs 17,5 %.
- Atbilstīgi tematiskajām stratēģijām par **gaisa piesārņojumu un atkritumu rašanās novēršanai un atkritumu pārstrādei** tika racionalizēti, skaidroti un vienkāršoti šo jomu pamattiesību akti. Jaunā gaisa kvalitātes direktīva apvieno 5 atsevišķas direktīvas, un jaunā **pamatdirektīva par atkritumiem** apvieno atsevišķas direktīvas par bīstamajiem atkritumiem un eļļas atkritumiem.
- Jaunā **pamatdirektīva par ūdeni** sniedz vienotu, saskaņotu politikas plānošanas, izpildes un ziņošanas sistēmu, lai aizsargātu un atjaunotu tīru ūdeni visā Eiropā, un samazina ūdens nozarē direktīvu skaitu no 18 līdz 10.
- Jaunā **direktīva par veselības aizsardzību** un drošību darbā vienkāršo un racionalizē dalībvalstu ziņojumus par pamatdirektīvas īstenošanu praksē un atsevišķām direktīvām. Turpmāk dalībvalstīm būs jāsniedz tikai viens ziņojums piecos gados.

### 3.2. Uzlabotas darba metodes un vienkāršotas procedūras

Komisija aktīvi aicina vairāk izmantot informācijas tehnoloģijas, lai uzlabotu darba procedūras.

- Jaunā **Kopējā publiskā iepirkuma vārdnīca** (Eiropas Savienībā standartizēts iepirkumu apraksts) atvieglo publiskā iepirkuma iespēju apzināšanu visā ES neatkarīgi no tā, kuras valsts valodā rīko iepirkumu. Modeļi, ko izmanto valsts iestādes, lai *ES Oficiālajā Vēstnesī* publicētu paziņojumus, tika standartizēti un automatizēti, tādēļ publicēšanas laiku bija iespējams saīsināt no 12 līdz 5 dienām. Abi jauninājumi ir uzlabojuši publiskā iepirkuma tirgu pārredzamību. Katru dienu ES tīmekļa vietnē „Elektroniskā ikdienas informācija par konkursiem” (TED) tiek sniegta informācija par uzņēmējdarbības iespējām publiskajā sektorā vairāk nekā 1 miljarda euro vērtībā.
- Pie **Kopienas muitas kodeksa** vienkāršošanas var minēt ES tiesību aktu modernizēšanu muitas jomā un elektronisko dokumentu sistēmu izveidi muitas iestādēm un uzņēmējiem. Par ierastu lietu kļūst muitas deklarāciju un pavaddokumentu elektroniska iesniegšana. Atļauju saņēmušie tirgotāji varēs elektroniski deklarēt preces un maksāt muitas nodevas dalībvalstī, kurā tie atrodas, neatkarīgi no tā, uz kuru vietu ES muitas teritorijā preces nogādātas, kur tās izvestas vai kur tās patērēs. Kad apvienotā sistēma būs pilnīgā darba kārtībā, tā uzņēmējiem varētu radīt 2,5 miljardus euro ietaupījumus gadā.
- **Vispārējās regulas par kohēzijas politiku** 55. panta grozījumi vienkāršoja noteikumus projektiem ar maziem ienākumiem. Proporcionalitātes noteikumu mazo darījumu uzraudzībai (kopējās izmaksas nepārsniedz 200 000 euro) aizstāja ar atkāpi, kas atļauj

nepiemērot šo pantu darījumiem, kurus līdzfinansējis Eiropas Sociālais fonds un Eiropas Reģionālās attīstības fonds vai Kohēzijas fonds, ja kopējās izmaksas nepārsniedz 1 000 000 euro.

### 3.3. Labi funkcionējošs iekšējais tirgus

Iekšējais tirgus ir bijis un būs vienkāršošanas dzinulis Eiropas Savienībā, kas atļāva sakopot milzīgus nacionālo normatīvo aktus vienā tiesību aktā.

- Ar **vienotajiem noteikumiem par gaisa pārvadājumu pakalpojumu sniegšanu** Kopienā pārskata tā dēvēto gaisa transporta liberalizācijas „tiesību aktu trešo kopumu”. Tie radītu lielāku patērētāju izvēli, zemākas maksas un lielāku konkurenci. Arī bankrota risks un negatīvās sekas pasažieriem mazināsies, ja noteiks stingrākas prasības jaunām aviosabiedrībām un tās labāk pārraudzīs. Bankroti pasažieriem vidēji izmaksā 15,6 miljonu euro gadā, ieskaitot repatriācijas izmaksas un iepriekšēju rezervāciju anulēšanu. Gadā patērētāji ietaupītu vidēji 2,4 miljonus euro, ja gaisa pārvadātāju pirmajos divos darbības gados bankrotu skaitu varētu samazināt par 50 %.
- Pārskatītā direktīva par **dzelzeļu sistēmas savstarpēju izmantojamību** Kopienā modernizē transportlīdzekļu sertifikācijas noteikumus. Tika aplēsts, ka nākamos 15 gadus dzelzeļa pārvadājumu uzņēmumiem un ražotājiem radīsies 200-280 miljoni euro lieli sertifikācijas izmaksu ietaupījumi.
- Jaunā regula par pesticīdu **maksimālo pieļaujamo atlieku līmeni** (MAL) pārtikā un barībā ar 100 000 MAL, kas noteikti ES, aizstāj aptuveni 500 000 MAL, kas noteikti valstī, un palīdz uzņēmumiem, jo tiem vairs nav jāiesniedz daudzie pieteikumi dažādās dalībvalstīs.
- „**PVN dokumentu kopums**” ieviesa jaunus noteikumus pakalpojumu sniegšanas jomā. Tādējādi nodokļus par pakalpojumiem, kurus viens uzņēmums sniedz citam uzņēmumam, uzliks klienta valstī. Tas kalpotu par impulsu, lai uzņēmumi sniegtu pakalpojumus visā Kopienā. Tajā arī ir iekļauta „vienas pieturas miniagentūra” telesakaru, apraides un televīzijas pakalpojumiem un elektroniskās tirdzniecības pakalpojumiem Eiropas Savienībā reģistrētiem uzņēmumiem, kā arī procedūra, kas paredz, ka uzņēmumi, kas nav reģistrēti valstī, kurā maksājams pievienotās vērtības nodoklis, var pieprasīt tā atmaksu.
- **Uzņēmējdarbības tiesību** jomā 2007. gadā steidzīgi pieņemtā direktīva par apvienošanu un sadalīšanu racionalizē pārrobežu apvienošanu, tādējādi akciju sabiedrībām rodas 17 miljoni euro lieli ietaupījumi.

### 4. GAIDĀMIE REZULTĀTI. IZSTRĀDĒ ESOŠIE PRIEKŠLIKUMI UN IESTĀŽU ASPEKTI

Padome un Eiropas Parlaments pieņēma vienkāršošanas pasākumus, kas 2008. gada janvārī vēl bija 16, bet 2009. gada janvārī sasniedza jau 39. Tomēr 50 vienkāršošanas priekšlikumi joprojām atrodas Padomē un Eiropas Parlamentā (3. pielikums). Ir svarīgi, lai iestādes virzītu minēto priekšlikumu izskatīšanu, lai uzņēmēji, pilsoņi un valsts pārvaldes iegūtu vēl lielākas priekšrocības.

- Jaunā ES direktīva par ieguldījumu fondiem „**UKIPV**” (uzņēmumi, kas veic kolektīvos ieguldījumus pārvedu vērtspapīros) patērētājiem sniegs pieeju profesionāli pārvaldītiem ieguldījumiem ar izdevīgiem nosacījumiem; UKIPV pārvaldītājiem atļauj izvērst savas pārrobežu darbības un gūt ietaupījumus un apjomradītus ietaupījumus; turklāt

ieguldītājiem ir plašāka ieguldījumu fondu izvēle, kuriem ir zemākas darbības izmaksas; un aizsargās privātos ieguldītājus, pārliecinoties, ka tie, ieguldot UKIPV, saņem skaidru, saprotamu un svarīgu informāciju. Direktīva aizstās un apvienos vienā tekstā 10 spēkā esošas direktīvas.

- **Uzņēmējdarbības tiesību** jomā ir iesniegti vairāki svarīgi priekšlikumi uzņēmējdarbības vienkāršošanai ES un būtisku ietaupījumu gūšanai. Starp minētajiem pasākumiem ir jaunās direktīvas priekšlikums Padomes regulai par Eiropas privātā uzņēmuma statūtiem (priekšlikums ierosina samazināt uzņēmumiem noteiktās tulkošanas un publicēšanas prasības, kas ļautu ietaupīt aptuveni 600 miljonus euro) un vēl viens priekšlikums par ziņošanas un dokumentēšanas prasībām **apvienošanu un sadalīšanu gadījumā**.
- Jaunā **regula par kosmētikas līdzekļiem** aizstās vairāk nekā 3500 lappušu normatīvā teksta. Priekšlikumā uzņēmumu izmaksas ir samazinātas vismaz par 50 %, vienlaikus saglabājot nemainīgus un augstus drošības standartus. Tajā ir skaidrotas ražojumu nekaitīguma novērtējuma procedūras un vienkāršoti jaunu kosmētikas līdzekļu paziņošanas noteikumi. Kosmētikas līdzekļu tirgū Eiropā tam būs zīmīga iedarbība, jo šis tirgus ir aptuveni 65 miljardus euro vērts un tieši un netieši rada vairāk nekā 350 000 darba vietu.
- Farmaceutisko „**izmaiņu**” **regulu** pārstādāšana saskaņos kritērijus, lai vērtētu pārskatīšanas un apstiprināšanas izmaiņas un termiņus. Atbilstīgi datiem ik gadu vidējais ģenērisko zāļu ražotājs saistībā ar zālēm saskaras ar vairāk nekā 1500 izmaiņām, turpretī lielam farmācijas uzņēmumam jātiek galā ar vairāk nekā 12 000 izmaiņu. Priekšlikums uzlabos uzņēmumu konkurētspēju, mazinot loģistikas problēmas, piemēram, nepieciešamību veidot viena un tā paša produkta dažādu variantu uzkrājumus dažādu valstu tirgiem. Vienkāršotais tiesiskais regulējums palīdzēs uzņēmumiem, sevišķi MVU, izvērst savu darbību pārējos ES tirgos.
- Jaunais „**transportlīdzekļu drošības dokumentu kopums**” vienkāršos spēkā esošo normatīvo vidi, jo tiks atceltas 150 direktīvas par transportlīdzekļu tipa apstiprinājumu, un noteiks prasību par pasažieru transportlīdzekļu obligātu aprīkošanu ar drošības aprīkojumu un riepu spiediena kontroles sistēmām, kas būtiski uzlabos transportlīdzekļa drošību un samazinās CO2 emisijas.
- Direktīva par **patērētāju tiesībām** veicinās labāku iekšējā tirgus darbību (uzņēmums – patērētājs), mazinot uzņēmumu atturību pret pārrobežu tirdzniecību. Tā mazinās sašķeltību un vienkāršos normatīvo vidi, atceļot 4 direktīvas. Turklāt direktīva uzlabos normatīvo vidi, un patērētāju līguma standartnoteikumu kopums būtiski samazinās izmaksas atbilstības nodrošināšanai.
- Priekšlikumu kopuma par **energoefektivitāti** mērķis ir panākt enerģijas ietaupījumus svarīgākajās nozarēs, piemēram, uzlabojot tiesību aktus par ēkām un enerģiju patērējošu ražojumu energoefektivitātes jomā. Gadā viena māsaimniecība vidēji varētu gūt vismaz 1000 euro lielus enerģijas ietaupījumus.
- **Statistikas nozarē par preču iekšējo tirdzniecību Kopienā (Intrastat)** Eiropas tiesību aktos noteiktais ziņošanas sliksni atbrīvos aptuveni 370 000 uzņēmumus no ziņošanas pienākuma. Tādējādi uzņēmumu skaits, kuriem ir pienākums ziņot, samazinātos par aptuveni 52 % sešu gadu laikā (2004. gadā no 720 000 līdz 350 000 — 2010. gadā).
- Priekšlikums par **barības laišanu tirgū un izmantošanu** uzlabos šīs nozares uzņēmumu inovāciju un konkurētspēju. Jaunā regula atcels 7 direktīvas (100 lpp. vietā 30). Attiecībā uz atsevišķiem produktiem (bioproteīni) tiks atcelta arī apgrūtinotā procedūra par atļaujas

piešķiršanu pirms laišanas tirgū, jo tā nav samērīga ar risku. Izmaksu samazinājuma uzskatāmībai: atļauja par jaunu bioproteīnu ražošanas nozarei pavisam izmaksā aptuveni 481 000 euro.

- Priekšlikums pārstrādāt direktīvu par **piesārņojuma integrētu novēršanu un kontroli (IPPC)** vienā likumdošanas instrumentā apvienos 7 direktīvas par rūpnieciskajām emisijām. Spēkā esošajās direktīvās tā svītros liekās daļas, vienkāršos prasības atļaujas piešķiršanai, mazinās uzņēmēju ziņošanas pienākumu un racionalizēs dalībvalstu ziņošanu. Priekšlikums ļaus būtiski ietaupīt administratīvās izmaksas (apmēram 32 miljonus euro gadā) un vēl vairāk mazinās dalībvalstu (valsts vai reģionu) administratīvo slogu, ļaujot ietaupīt pat 150-300 miljonus euro gadā.
- "**GSM dokumentu kopums**" ir vērst uz to, lai 900 MHz un 1800 MHz spektrs (GSM diapazonā) būtu pieejams inovatīvākai izmantošanai. Šis dokumentu kopums atceļ ierobežojošo regulu, kas vairs neatspoguļo tehnoloģisko attīstību un kavē izplatīto mobilo pakalpojumu izmantošanu.
- Kopīgās lauksaimniecības politikas "efektivitātes pārbaude" īsteno **vienreizējā maksājuma shēmas** vienkāršošanu. Tas īpaši iezīmē atteikšanos no divu paralēlu sistēmu (saistītais un dalītais atbalsts) uzturēšanas un pāreju uz dalīto atbalstu. Dalītā atbalsta mērķis ir panākt, lai administratīvais slogs Apvienotās Karalistes lauksaimniekiem tiktu samazināts par 0,63 miljoniem euro. Vienkāršošana arī paredz atcelt prasību par 10 % atmatā atstātu zemi. Lauksaimnieki var izmantot visu savu zemi un tiem vairs nav jāpilda saistītās procedūras, un dalībvalstīm vairs nav jākontrolē šis pasākums. Priekšrocību uzskatāmībai: sagaidāms, ka administratīvais slogs Anglijas lauksaimniekiem vien samazināsies par 4,4 miljoniem euro<sup>5</sup>;
- Visus noteikumus par **zvejas darbību** kontroli apvienos vienā regulējuma sistēmā, īpaši liekot uzsvāru uz lielāku moderno tehnoloģiju izmantošanu un pieslēgšanos datubāzēm.
- **Telesakaru dokumentu kopuma** reforma panāks kopējo administratīvo izmaksu samazinājumu ražošanas nozarē, jo turpmāk regulēs mazāku attiecīgo tirgu skaitu ar *ex ante* konkurences noteikumiem, vienkāršos tirgus analīzes procedūras, izveidos Eiropas regulējošu struktūru un reformēs spektra pārvaldību. Elektronisko sakaru pakalpojumi un infrastruktūra ir ekonomikas pamats, un šajā nozarē gūtie uzlabojumi nodrošinās priekšrocības visai ES.
- Priekšlikums uzlabot **reģionālās politikas programmas** ir virzīts uz to, lai atvieglotu finanšu pārvaldību un paātrinātu nepieciešamo Kopienas finanšu resursu novirzīšanu kā darbības programmām, tā projektiem. Komisija īpaši ierosināja, lai kopīgās projektu izmaksas atmaksātu ar vienreizēju maksājumu un Eiropas Savienība pilnībā atmaksātu valsts iestādēm valsts atbalstu, kas avansā izmaksāts saņēmējiem. Minētās izmaiņas īpaši palīdzēs MVU.
- Mūsdienīgāka **valsts sociālā nodrošinājuma shēmu** koordinēšana atvieglos darba ņēmēju un to ģimeņu brīvu pārvietošanos Eiropas Savienībā. Tās priekšrocības izmantos arī 173 miljoni Eiropas veselības apdrošināšanas kartes īpašnieki, kas tāpat kā dalībvalsts pilsoņi var izmantot veselības aprūpi, uz laiku uzturoties šajā valstī.

Padomes un Eiropas Parlamentā iesniegto priekšlikumu skaits aug. Tādēļ ir būtiski, ka tiek pārbaudīts, ar kādiem līdzekļiem var paātrināt to pieņemšanu, un darīts viss, lai panāktu vienošanos, ja iespējams, koplēmuma procedūras pirmajā lasījumā. Komisija ir gandarīta par

Eiropas Parlamenta nodomu izveidot īpašas struktūras, kas vairo vienkāršošanu, kā norādīts nesen pieņemtajā Medina Ortega ziņojumā.

Eiropas Parlaments ir apstiprinājis, ka tas vēlas, lai Komisija izmantotu pārstrādāšanu kā parastu likumdošanas tehniku, pat tad, ja ierosināta spēkā esoša dokumenta „pārskatīšana”. Tomēr ir svarīgi, lai Padome un Eiropas Parlaments pārņemtu tiesību aktu vienkāršošanas principus un ideju, saglabājot pieņemtus priekšlikumus pēc iespējas vienkāršākus un paātrinot lēmumu pieņemšanas procedūru, lai uzņēmumi, pilsoņi un valsts pārvaldes varētu izmantot priekšrocības.

## 5. KODIFICĒŠANA

Komisija ne tikai vienkāršo tiesību aktus, bet tos arī kodificē, apvienojot vienā dokumentā pamattiesību aktus un visus turpmākos grozījumus. Tiesību akts top skaidrāks un samazina Kopienas *acquis* apjomu.

Līdz šim Komisija ir pabeigusi 229 tiesību aktu kodificēšanu. 142 no tiem tika kodificēti, pieņemti un publicēti *Oficiālajā Vēstnesī* (102 Komisijas tiesību akti un 40 Eiropas Parlamenta un Padomes tiesību akti). Ar šiem 142 kodificētajiem tiesību aktiem aizstāja 729 iepriekšējos dokumentus, kas atbilst aptuveni 1300 lappusēm *Oficiālajā Vēstnesī*.

Padomē un Eiropas Parlamentā vēl tiek izskatīti 87 tiesību akti.

Ir izskatīta lielākā daļa uzkrāto tiesību aktu tulkojumu, kurus paredzēts kodificēt jaunajās valodās. Atlikušie priekšlikumi par kodificēšanas programmas pabeigšanu, kura tika pārskatīta 2006. gadā, tiks iesniegti 2009. gadā kopā ar ziņojumu, kurā sniegti visi programmas rezultāti. Kodificēšanai 2009. gadā tika atlasīts 21 jauns tiesību akts (6. pielikums).

## 6. TURPMĀKĀ RĪCĪBA

### 6.1. 2009. gadā paredzētās iniciatīvas

Komisijas likumdošanas un darba programmā 2009. gadam<sup>6</sup> (7. pielikums) Komisija iekļāva 33 vienkāršošanas iniciatīvas.

Piemēram,

- Direktīvas 2000/35/EK par **maksājumu kavējumu novēršanu komercdarījumos** pārskatīšana mudinās valsts iestādes un uzņēmumus nekavēt maksājumus piegādātājiem un būs par stimulu tam, lai kreditori pieprasītu kompensēt kavētus maksājumus. Šī iniciatīva ir iekļauta „Eiropas Mazās uzņēmējdarbības aktā” un „Eiropas ekonomikas atveseļošanas plānā”.
- EK tiesību aktu par **lauksaimniecībā un mežsaimniecībā izmantojamiem traktoriem** vienkāršošana, ar vienu regulu aizstājot 24 direktīvas;
- Regulas (EK) Nr. 44/2001 grozīšana un modernizēšana, lai regulu pielāgotu jauniem starptautiskiem instrumentiem un nodrošinātu **spriedumu atzīšanu un izpildi civillietās un komerclietās**, atsakoties no pastarpinātiem soļiem, kas jāveic pilsoņiem (ekzekvatūra), lai ārvalstīs tiesas nolēmums tiktu atzīts un izpildīts.

- **Zvejniecības un akvakultūras nozares tirgu kopīgās organizācijas** reforma, kas pievērš uzmanību ilgtspējīgām zvejas un tirgvedības darbībām. Tā paredz pielāgojumus tirgus attīstībai, lielāku saskaņotību ar pārējiem kopīgās zivsaimniecības politikas elementiem, kā arī ar saistītām Kopienas politikas jomām (tirdzniecība, veselības un patērētāju aizsardzība, vide), un veicinās arī plašāku elektronisko palīgīdzekļu izmantošanu.

Turklāt Komisija joprojām sadarbojas ar dalībvalstīm, lai vēl noskaidrotu, kādā veidā vienkāršot regulas kohēzijas politikas jomā un samazināt saņēmēju administratīvo slogu.

## 6.2. *Acquis* izskatīšana un vienkāršošanas darbības nākotnē

Komisija veica vispusīgu *acquis* pārbaudi, kā paziņots Otrajā labāka regulējuma Eiropas Savienībā stratēģiskajā pārskatā.

Vispirms veica sistemātiska *acquis* pārskatīšanu, lai apzinātu vissvarīgākos reglamentējošos instrumentus. Pēc šīs izskatīšanas tika atlasīti aptuveni 3600 tiesību akti. Minētos aktus izskatīja vēl detalizētāk, lai novērtētu, vai tie ir moderni un vai būtu apsverama to vienkāršošana.

Visus rezultātus pa politikas jomām publicēs Eiropas vienkāršošanas tīmekļa vietnē<sup>7</sup>, lai sniegtu skaidru pārskatu par Komisijas līdzšinējiem vienkāršošanas centieniem.

Pārbaudes rezultāti norāda uz to, kādā mērā

- vienkāršošana ir jau notikusi,
- tiek plānota vienkāršošana 2009. gadā,
- ir apsverama vienkāršošana nākamajā Komisijas sasaukumā vai
- vienkāršošana netiek plānota, proti, tiesību akts ir skaidrs, atbilstīgs un proporcionāls saviem politiskajiem mērķiem. Dažos no šiem gadījumiem, tiesību aktu izmaiņas varētu sniegt labumu, tomēr to atsvērtu izmaksas un slogs, kas radīsies uzņēmumiem un valsts pārvaldēm, sevišķi saistībā ar transponēšanu.

Kļūst redzams, ka gūti lieli panākumi. Apmēram divas trešdaļas tiesību aktu, kas galvenokārt aptver lauksaimniecību, iekšējo tirgu, transportu, uzņēmējdarbību, veselību un vidi, tika vienkāršotas vienkāršošanas caurviju programmā, kodificēšanas programmā vai citās Komisijas iniciatīvās, vai tagad ir iekļautas gaidāmajos vienkāršošanas priekšlikumos 2009. gadam. (2. pielikums)

Aktuālā stāvokļa apzināšana sagatavo augsni turpmākai vienkāršošanai. Komisija ar spēkā esošos tiesību aktu pārbaudi nozares kontekstā panāk aizvien integrētāku pieeju vienkāršošanai. Vienkāršošanas iniciatīvās nākotnē varētu integrēt papildu 81 darbību (1. pielikums).

Piemēram,

- 15 tehnisko harmonizēšanas direktīvu saskaņošana ar lēmumu par **ražojumu tirdzniecības vienoto sistēmu**. Tas paredz vienotus elementus, kurus parasti standartizētā veidā izmanto

tiesību aktu tehniskajā harmonizēšanā un kurus vajadzētu iekļaut turpmākajos tiesību aktos. Ir pamatoti nodrošināt konsekventāku normatīvo vidi un radīt vienotu likumdošanas „kultūru”. Tas uzlabos mūsu tiesību aktu kvalitāti un mazinās administratīvo slogu.

- **Kopējā lauksaimniecības politikā** īstenošanas noteikumu vienkāršošana pēc tam, kad būs pieņemta „efektivitātes pārbaude” attiecībā uz intervences pasākumu pārvaldību.
- Tiesību aktu pārskatīšana **veselības apdraudējuma jomā** (infekcijas slimības un ķīmisks, bioloģisks un radioaktīvs apdraudējums) un **dzīvnieku veselības, labturības un barības jomā**.
- Vēl lielāka **statistikas** joma atslogošana ar **EUTSM** (Eiropas uzņēmumu un tirdzniecības statistikas modernizēšana) programmas palīdzību. Tā uzlabos datu vākšanas metodes dalībvalstīs, vairāk izmantojot administratīvos un grāmatvedības datus, labākas paraugu ņemšanas shēmas, kā arī labāk un aktīvāk izmantojot pieejamus avotus.

## 7. NOBEIGUMA PIEZĪMES

Kopš 2005. gadā sāka normatīvās vides vienkāršošanas stratēģija, to integrēja Komisijas darbā. Komisija ar vairākām koordinētām darbībām, ir izveidojusi politisku un praktisku rīcības sistēmu, kas pilsoņiem, uzņēmumiem un valsts pārvaldēm sniedz acīmredzamu ieguvumu. Cenšoties veidot skaidrākus un saprotamākus tiesību aktus, apmēram 1300 tiesību aktus jeb apmēram 10 % no *acquis* ir ierosināts svītrot no ES tiesību aktu kopuma.

Tiesību aktu vienkāršošana ir nepārtraukts process. *Acquis* izskatīšana ir kā momentuzņēmums, uz kā balstīsies turpmākais darbs nākotnē. Programma, kuru sāka ar dažām nesaistītām iniciatīvām, tagad aptver visas politikas jomas un ir vairāk vērsta uz nozarēm. Tas nozīmē, ka notiek pilnīgi visu to tiesību aktu pārbaude, kuri skar attiecīgo politikas jomu, lai atklātu pārklāšanos, trūkumus, nesaderību un pārmērīgu normatīvo slogu. Mērķis ir pa nozarēm novērtēt kopējo regulējuma efektivitāti.

Komisija, turpinot vienkāršošanas programmu, no pārējām ES iestādēm un dalībvalstīm pieprasīs politisko atbalstu. Eiropas Parlaments un Padome ir aicinātas darīt visu iespējamo, lai pieņemtu izstrādē esošos priekšlikumus pēc iespējas drīz un lēmuma pieņemšanas procesā saglabātu tajos paredzētos vienkāršošanas noteikumus. Dalībvalstis tiek mudinātas turpināt savu vienkāršošanas programmu un piemērot ES tiesību aktus vienkāršošanas garā, nepievienojot liekus pasākumus.

Eiropas pilsoņi un uzņēmumi ikdienā saskaras ar ES, valsts un reģionu tiesību aktu sajaukumu. Nodrošināt, ka šis pamatregulējums pēc iespējas labāk kalpo savam nolūkam, — saglabāt izaugsmi un labklājību, lieki nepalielinot slogu, — iespējams tikai tad, ja vienkāršošanas centienus koordinē visos minētajos līmeņos.

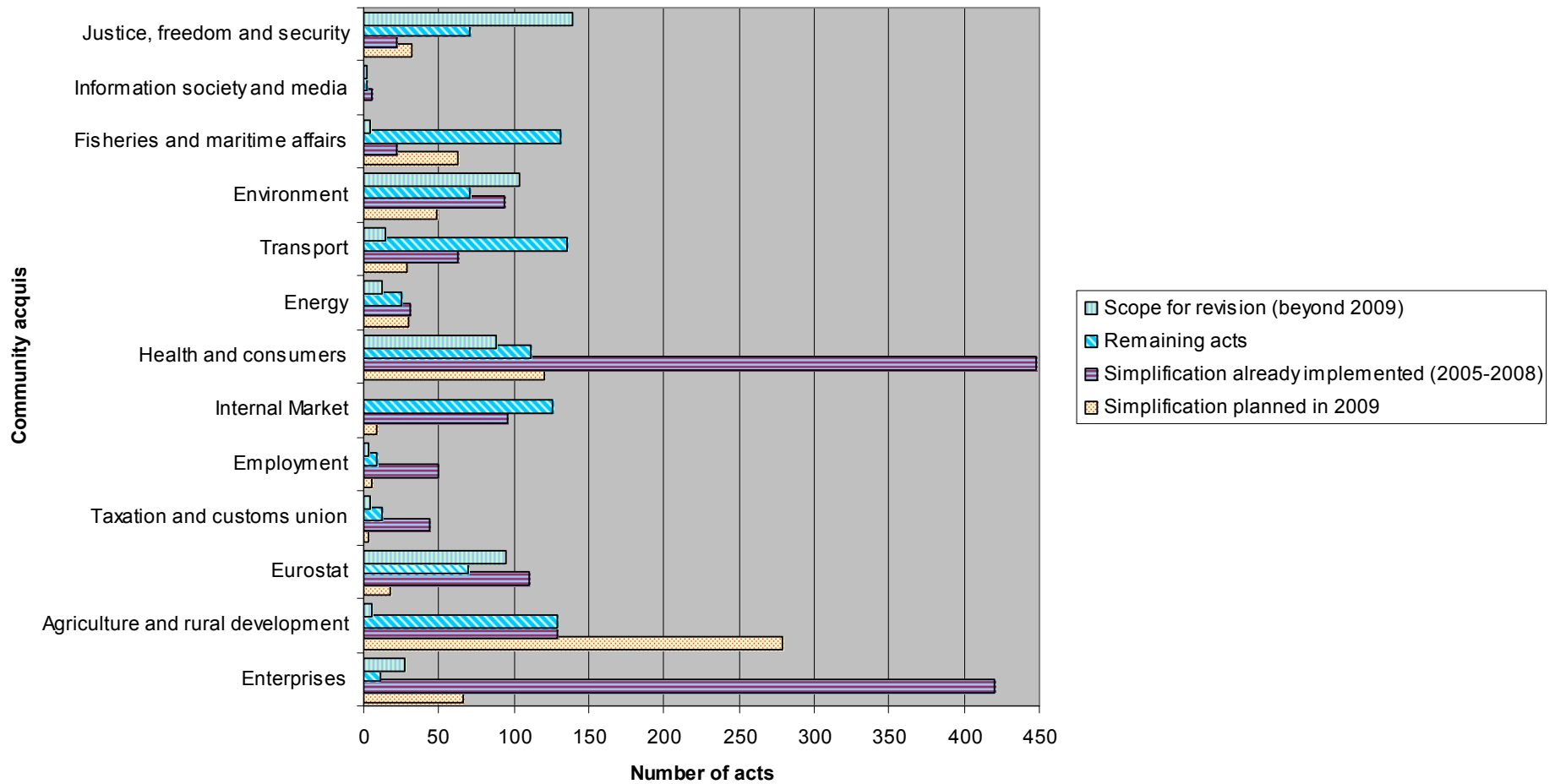
