The Mission of Norway to the European Union presents its compliments to the Council of the European Union and acknowledges receipt of the notification of the Council dated 3 July 2020, relating to the Council recommendation 2020/912 of 30 June 2020 (and the notification of the Council dated 17 July 2020, relating to the Council recommendation (EU) 2020/1052 of 16 July 2020 amending Council recommendation (EU) 2020/912 of 30 June 2020) on the temporary restriction on non-essential travel into the EU and the possible lifting of such restriction.
