| | Adoption of the legislative act |

- On 30 Mars 2022 the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 14 July 2022².
- On 17 January 2024 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council³.

- 4. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 64/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Slovakia</u> abstaining.
- 5. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 6. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
