### 'I/A' ITEM NOTE

Subject: Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EU) 2024/1348 as regards the establishment of a list of safe countries of origin at Union level (**first reading**)  
- Adoption of the legislative act

---

1. On 16 April 2025 the Commission submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 78(2), point (d) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 23 October 2025<sup>2</sup>.
3. On 10 February 2026 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal<sup>3</sup>. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council<sup>4</sup> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 67/25, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with Belgium and Hungary abstaining.
5. The statement for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the Addendum to this note.
6. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
