Subject:	Draft Council Implementing Decision setting out a recommendation on addressing the deficiencies identified in the 2019 evaluation of <b>Slovakia</b> on the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of <b>return</b> - Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption

- 1. Following the Council's adoption of Regulation (EU) No 1053/2013 establishing an evaluation and monitoring mechanism to verify the application of the Schengen acquis, a team of experts from the Member States and the Commission carried out an evaluation of Slovakia on the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of return in 2019.
- 2. In accordance with that Regulation, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation designed to address the deficiencies identified in the course of the evaluation and ensure that Slovakia applies all Schengen rules related to return correctly and effectively.
- 3. The Working Party for Schengen Matters (Evaluation), including the Mixed Committee partners Norway, Iceland, Switzerland and Liechtenstein, agreed on the proposal for the Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation on 16 February 2021.
