Subject:	Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Directive 2009/21/EC on compliance with flag State requirements – Preparation for the trilogue

In document ST 6284/24 INIT, the following corrections should be made:

- On page 48, in line 56, the text in the fourth column should read as follows:

“(b) ensuring that ships entitled to fly their flag have been surveyed, **as far as possible** in accordance with the survey guidelines under the Harmonized System of Survey and Certification (HSSC) ~~and following its annexes as far as is deemed necessary;~~”
- On page 51, in line 58 the text in the fourth column should read as follows:

“Member States shall ensure that any deficiencies, **including safety, environmental and social concerns**, confirmed or revealed by an inspection carried out in accordance with paragraph 2(c) are rectified within an appropriate time-frame, as determined by the flag State.”

3. On page 53, in line 64, the text in the fourth column should read as follows:

“3. Each Member State shall **ensure that** ~~develop or maintain~~ a design review and technical decision-making capability, ~~whether its own or delegated~~, according to the size and type of its fleet, **are developed or maintained.**”
