In line with these provisions, the Commission shall present to the European Parliament and the Council a proposal for a transfer of appropriations from the reserve for the EGF to the relevant budgetary line in parallel to the proposal for a decision to mobilise the EGF.

d) Detailed grounds for the Increase

In the proposal for Decision COM(2026) 3, the Commission concluded, in accordance with all applicable provisions of the EGF Regulation, that the conditions for a financial contribution from the EGF to application EGF/2025/007 BE/Casa are met.

The amount of EUR 1 916 733, requested by the Belgian authorities, will contribute to the costs of a coordinated package of eligible personalised services for 416 targeted beneficiaries following job displacements in Casa International and Casa Logistics in Belgium, in line with the intervention criteria set out in Article 4(2), point (a) of the EGF Regulation. The financial contribution from the EGF aims to provide assistance for re-integrating the affected persons into the labour market.
