Subject:	COUNCIL DECISION appointing one member of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for Estonia

- 1. The Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers, by its Decisions of 20 September¹ and 25 October 2022². However, it remained to appoint certain members and alternate members at a later stage.
- 2. Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union³, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council for a period of two years.

- 3. A nomination of one member for Estonia, of the renewed Advisory Committee, has been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 6408/23⁴.
- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee could therefore suggest that the Council:
 - (a) adopts the Council Decision appointing one member of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for Estonia, as an "A" item, and
 - (b) decides to publish the Decision for information in the Official Journal of the European Union.
