Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing the Union Secure Connectivity Programme for the period 2023-2027 (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 16 February 2022 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 189(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. On 14 February 2023 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>2</sup>.

- 3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to:
  - confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European
    Parliament's position as set out in PE-CONS 65/22 and the joint statements as set out in the <u>Addendum 1</u> to this note, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting;
  - decide to publish the statements set out in <u>Addendum 1</u> in the C series of the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
- 4. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum 1</u> and Addendum 2 to this note.
- 5. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
