Subject: Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL laying down measures for a high level of public sector interoperability across the Union (Interoperable Europe Act) **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 18 November 2022, the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 172 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 22 March 2023².
3. The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 24 May 2023³.
4. The European Data Protection Supervisor delivered its opinion on 13 January 2023⁴
5. On 6 February 2024, the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁵.

6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 73/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
7. The statement for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the Addendum to this note.
8. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
