- On 12 September 2018 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the 1. Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 12 December 2018<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 17 April 2019<sup>3</sup>.

Due to the special circumstances, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision (EU) 2021/26<sup>5</sup>, that the Council uses the written procedure for the adoption of its position at first reading on the draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on preventing the dissemination of terrorist content online, as set out in document 14308/20, and the Statement of reasons, as set out in document 14308/20 ADD 1.
