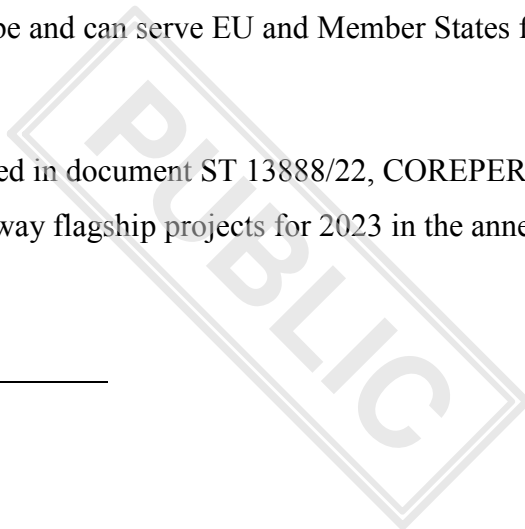

**DOCUMENT PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC (08.03.2023)**

1. The Commission put forward a draft proposal for a list of Global Gateway flagship projects for 2023 (WK 809/2023 INIT) on 19 January 2023 and presented it to the Relex Counsellors - Horizontal Questions Working Party meeting on 20 January 2023.
2. Based on the written comments provided by Member States and previous discussions, the Presidency prepared a revised proposal for a list of Global Gateway flagship projects for 2023 which was discussed in the Relex Counsellors - Horizontal Questions Working Party meeting on 3 and 17 February 2023, taking into account the criteria identified in document ST 10532/22.
3. Agreement on the list was reached on 17 February 2023.

4. The list contains the Global Gateway priority projects for 2023 aiming to reflect the comprehensive EU offer to partners across the globe and can serve EU and Member States for communication purposes.
5. In line with the Global Gateway Governance defined in document ST 13888/22, COREPER is therefore invited to endorse the list of Global Gateway flagship projects for 2023 in the annex.
