### **STATEMENT 12/99**

### **Statement by the Netherlands delegation**

The Netherlands states that this increase in the budget for the transitional year 1999 has no implications for the Netherlands' approach to the future financial perspective. The Netherlands argues for genuine zero growth in EU expenditure overall and per category, including category III.

### **STATEMENT 13/99**

#### Statement by the Spanish and Greek delegations

Spain and Greece state that the figures in the financial perspective approved at Edinburgh by way of commitment appropriations, not payment appropriations, for 1999 are the ones that should be used as a reference for the 2000-2006 financial perspective for the 15 current Member States. Consequently, Spain and Greece do not agree with the Netherlands delegation's approach involving zero growth in overall EU expenditure and specifically category III.

#### **STATEMENT 14/99**

### **Statement by the Netherlands delegation:**

The Netherlands states that this increase in the budget for the transitional year 1999 has no implications for the Netherlands' approach to the future financial perspective. The Netherlands argues for genuine zero growth in EU expenditure overall and per category, including category III.

### **STATEMENT 15/99**

#### Statement by the Spanish and Greek delegations

Spain and Greece state that the figures in the financial perspective approved at Edinburgh by way of commitment appropriations, not payment appropriations, for 1999 are the ones that should be used as a reference for the 2000-2006 financial perspective for the 15 current Member States.

Consequently, Spain and Greece do not agree with the Netherlands delegation's approach involving zero growth in overall EU expenditure and specifically category III.

## STATEMENT 16/99

Statement by the Council on the extension of the Regulations to cover students only

"The Council reaffirms its commitment to extending the Regulations to all other insured persons not at present covered. Taking note, however, of the need to include students, and the problems encountered in reaching agreement on suitable coordination arrangements for other insured persons not at present covered, the Council has agreed that the extension to students should be given priority.

The Council recognises, however, that the Commission proposal on the extension of the coordination of national legislation concerning all other insured persons not at present covered remains before the Council and agrees, in this context, that the provisions relating to benefits in case of invalidity, old age and death (pensions) are an essential part of that extension, especially for persons residing in a Member State for the purpose of study or vocational training."

### STATEMENT 17/99

Statement by the Council and the Commission on recital 11 and the entry in Annex VI for the United Kingdom

"The Council and the Commission state that the entry in Annex VI for the United Kingdom is explained partly by the specific nature of the United Kingdom's own rules and partly by the fact that the system of coordinating social security schemes is not being extended to students as regards, in particular, invalidity. Consequently, this derogation is entirely without prejudice to solutions that may be adopted in future regarding extension to other risks or persons and will have to be reviewed at the forthcoming extension, to students in particular, of all the provisions on the coordination of social security schemes."

#### STATEMENT 18/99

Statement by the French, Greek, Italian and Portuguese delegations concerning the scope of the Regulation:

## "France, Greece, Italy and Portugal

- support the extension of the Regulations to students insured under a general or a special social security scheme and would recall that this is a commitment made by the Council on
   4 June 1998 when the Regulations were extended to the special schemes for civil servants;
- regret that this extension to students is only very limited, in particular since the provisions originally planned have been abandoned, yet no provision has been laid down to determine the national social security legislation applicable to the persons concerned."
