1. Commission proposal for a Regulation setting up a Union Regime for control of exports, transfer, brokering, technical assistance and transit of dual-use items (Recast)

The main focus of the meeting was the recast of the Dual Use Regulation and the follow-up to the third trilogue, which had taken place a week earlier in Strasbourg on 13 February. The Chair of the DUWP presented in detail the outcome of the third trilogue, emphasising that there was new momentum in the negotiations and substantial progress had been made which would pave the way for the long-awaited successful closure of the file. **DELETED**
