In document ST 7005/24 INIT, the following changes should be made:

1. On page 10, the footnote 18 should read: "On 4 March 2022, the Council triggered the Council Directive of 20 July **2001** ("Temporary Protection Directive") ..."
2. On page 13, under point 11, the fourth sentence should read: "In relation to health and safety, further adaptation **of** the relevant regulations and frameworks may need to better incorporate both the psychosocial risks linked to the digital transition, including negative impacts on mental health, and specific hazards stemming from climate change (in the case of jobs associated with exposure to extreme weather conditions) by encouraging their prevention, in addition to speeding up the setting of minimum standards regarding hazardous substances."

3. On page 14, the footnote 27 should read: "Such as to Directive 2003/88/EC of 4 November 2003 concerning certain aspects of the organisation of working time and Directive 2002/14/EC of 11 March **2002** establishing a general framework for informing and consulting employees in the European Community."
4. On page 15, under point 13, the second sentence should read: "... setting a framework for policy reforms and to prevent and combat social exclusion across generations from an early age through ensuring free and effective access for children in need **to** various services, such as early childhood education and care, education and school-based activities, at least one healthy meal each school day, and healthcare."
5. On page 29, in the Annex, the principle 15 should read: "Old-**age** income and pensions"
