Subject:	Joint Employment Report 2020
	- Decision to use the written procedure for adoption

- 1. In conformity with Article 148(5) of the Treaty on the functioning of the European Union (TFEU) provides that "the Council and the Commission shall make a joint annual report to the European Council on the employment situation in the Union and on the implementation of the guidelines for employment".
- 2. In addition, Article 148(1) of the TFEU states that "the European Council shall each year consider the employment situation in the Union and adopt conclusions thereon, on the basis of a joint annual report by the Council and the Commission".
- 3. The draft Joint Employment Report 2020 was finalised by the Employment Committee at its meeting on 19 February 2020.
- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 1) recommended on 11 March to send the document to Council (EPSCO) on 19 March 2020 for adoption.

- 5. Following the cancellation of the Council (EPSCO) session on 19 March, due to the outbreak of COVID-19, the Permanent Representative Committee (Part 1) agreed that the adoption should have been done as an A item in a forthcoming Council session.
- 6. However, in view of the current exceptional circumstances it will not be possible to adopt the report as an A item in a forthcoming Council session, as envisaged in document 6810/20.
- 7. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision 2020/430, that the Council uses the written procedure for the adoption of the Joint Employment Report 2020 (set out in document 6810/20).
