The SCA exchanged views on the Presidency drafting suggestions on the Commission's proposals for a Regulation on CAP Strategic Plans and for the Horizontal Regulation as set out in documents 7007/19 and 6981/19.

The SCA took note of delegations' and the Commission's comments on those elements.

The SCA also took note of the need to receive additional clarification from the Presidency and the Commission services on some elements of the proposal to make further progress on the two files.

4. Organisation of future work

The Presidency informed the SCA about the next SCA meeting on 11 March 2019 and on the "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council on 18 March 2019.

The Czech delegation expressed its intention to table an AOB item at the next SCA meeting requesting the Commission to provide information on the degree of preparedness for Brexit and the possible consequences of Brexit.

The Polish delegation expressed its intention to table an AOB item at the next "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council meeting on 18 March 2019, on the consequences of Brexit for the agricultural sector.

The Netherlands delegation expressed its intention to table two AOB items at the next

"Agriculture and Fisheries" Council meeting:

- i) Outcome of the Congress "CAP Strategic Plans - Exploring Eco-Climate Schemes" (Leeuwarden, 6-8 February 2019);
- ii) Decision by the Technical Board of Appeals of the European Patent Office regarding the possibility to patent the results of classical plant breeding.
