- T-139/25 Action for annulment concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine

1. By an application notified to the Council on 4 March 2025, the applicant, Qisda Optronics (Suzhou), has brought an action, pursuant to Article 263 TFEU, for the annulment of Council Decision (CFSP) 2024/3187 and Council Regulation (EU) 2024/3192 of 16 December 2024, concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine, and Council Decision (CFSP) 2025/394 and Council Regulation (EU) 2025/395 of 24 February 2025, concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine in so far as those acts concern the applicant.
2. In support of its application the applicant invokes three pleas in law:
 - error of assessment;
 - violation of the rights of defence;
 - infringement of freedom to conduct a business.

3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed **DELETED** and **DELETED**, legal advisers in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
