<u>The Committee</u> discussed the two questions set out in 7163/08 JAI 107 DATAPROTECT 9 USA 10. With regard to the first question, delegations discussed the issue of a deadline for endeavouring to complete the work of the High Level Contact Group.

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Further to some delegations' suggestions, the Chair concluded that if no agreement could be reached with the US, the joint EU-US declaration might have to be dropped. <u>The Committee</u> was informed by the Presidency on the outcome of the informal trilogue with the EP on 4 March 2008. With the exception of two amendments that require further discussion, <u>the Committee</u> endorsed the results of the trilogue, as far as an agreement on a text proposal could be reached.

In preparation of the next informal trilogue, scheduled for Strasbourg on 11 March 2008, <u>the Committee</u> examined compromise proposals submitted by the Commission concerning the future role of the European GNSS Supervisory Authority and the "Interinstitutional Galileo Conference" and agreed to consider them as a package, basis for the negotiations with the EP. Furthermore, it discussed three draft statements presented by the Commission services related to some outstanding issues concerning the draft Regulation.

#### Any other business

#### Adoption of ENV Council contribution (requested by AT)

The Austrian delegation raised a concern in relation to the text of the Council conclusions as set out in 7251/08, stating that, according to its understanding, one specific wording in this document had not been agreed at Council. The Presidency clarified the conclusions drawn by the President of the Council (Environment) on 3 March 2008 on the above-mentioned Council conclusions.

## - Sustainable criteria for biofuels (requested by FR)

The Presidency confirmed that the ad hoc Working Party on sustainability criteria for biofuels would also look at Annex VII to the proposed directive on energy from renewable sources, but only to the extent that this was necessary in order for the Working Party to conclude its work on the criteria themselves.

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#### - Anti-dumping on imported compressors from China (requested by NL)

As regards the draft Commission proposal to impose a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of certain compressors from China, NL, supported by CZ, DK, SE and UK, raise procedural questions, to which the Legal Service responds.

The Commission announces that the proposal will be sent officially to the Council immediately after stakeholders have been consulted.

<u>The Committee</u> takes note of <u>IT's</u> comments, with the support of <u>ES</u>, following to the information given by the Commissioner for Employment and Social Affairs to the Council (EPSCO) meeting on 29 February 2008 regarding a provisional decision, taken at a recent meeting by the Management Board of the European Institute for Gender Equality, that the language regime of the Management Board should be limited to <u>EN</u>, <u>FR</u> and the language of the Chair.

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
