"Poland declares that equality between women and men is enshrined in the treaties of the European Union as a fundamental right. Poland ensures equality between women and men within the framework of the Polish national legal system in accordance with internationally biding human rights instruments and within the framework of fundamental values and principles of the European Union. For these reasons, in place where the "gender" refers to gender equality Poland will interpret it as an equality between women and men in accordance with Articles 2 and 3 of the Treaty on European Union. Accordingly, other expressions containing the term "gender" will be interpreted by Poland as "sex", in accordance with Article 10, Article 19 para. 1 and Article 157(2) and (4) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union."

Statement by the Commission

"While the Commission can agree with reopening the security of information agreement (SIA) between the EU and the European Space Agency (ESA) for the purpose of bringing it up-to-date with the new rules in the area of information security, the Commission hereby wishes to put on record its interpretation of the wording 'to reflect the current relations between EU and ESA' cited as another reason for reopening the SIA (fifth paragraph of the draft letter to the High Representative).

The Commission can agree that the sentence in question calls for the inclusion into the negotiated SIA of clauses clarifying how classified information generated by ESA, notably in the context of the implementation of the EU Space Programme, is marked and handled as EU classified information (EUCI).

However, the Commission, as 'part of the EU' within the meaning of the SIA, is interpreting the sentence as not calling to include into the re-negotiated SIA a mandate to ESA to generate EUCI in the context of the Space Regulation. Indeed, that mandate can be based on a specific legal basis in appropriate instruments, such as the Financial Framework Partnership Agreement (FFPA) concluded with ESA for the implementation of the EU Space programme on the basis of the Commission's competences to execute the budget. In accordance with Article 40 TEU, it cannot be affected by the implementation of the Common Foreign Security Policy.

The Commission understands that the High Representative will be in charge of the negotiations where the agreement exclusively relates to CFSP. In accordance with Article 218 TFEU, the Commission is in the lead of the negotiations where the agreement relates principally to TFEU matters and where the CFSP elements are ancillary to the TFEU objectives."
