## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Directive 2014/59/EU and Regulation (EU) No 806/2014 as regards certain aspects of the minimum requirement for own funds and eligible liabilities (first reading)  - Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 18 April 2023 the Commission submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Central Bank</u> delivered its opinion on 5 July 2023<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 13 July 2023<sup>3</sup>.
- 4. On 27 February 2024 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal<sup>4</sup>. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 94/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 6. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
