Subject:	Management Board of the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work Appointment of Mr Carlos ARRANZ CORDERO, member for Spain, in place of Mr Francisco Javier PINILLA GARCÍA, who has resigned - Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Mr Francisco Javier PINILLA GARCÍA, as member of the Management Board of the above Agency in the governments' representatives category (for Spain).
2. Under Article 4 of Regulation (EU) 2019/126 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA), and repealing Council Regulation (EC) No 2062/94, members of the Management Board are appointed by the Council.
