Subject:	Council Decision of appointing eleven Member of the Management Board of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA)
	- Adoption

1. On 6 May 2021, the Council¹ renewed for another four years the first term appointments and adopted new appointments for altogether twelve Members of the Management Board of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) for the period 1 June 2021 - 31 May 2025, in accordance with Article 79 of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006².

Council Decision of 6 May 2021 appointing twelve members of the Management Board of the European Chemicals Agency, OJ C 185, 12.5.2021, p. 4–5;

Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), establishing a European Chemicals Agency, amending Directive 1999/45/EC and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 793/93 and Commission Regulation (EC) No 1488/94 as well as Council Directive 76/769/EEC and Commission Directives 91/155/EEC, 93/67/EEC, 93/105/EC, and 2000/21/EC (OJ L 396, 30.12.2006, p.1).

- 2. On the basis of the above Council Decision, between 31 January and 1 April 2025, the Council received five four-year nominations for a second term from Hungary, Italy, Luxembourg, Sweden, and The Netherlands. Six nominees from Austria, Finland, Slovenia, Spain, the Czech Republic, and Estonia have been nominated by their countries for a first term as Members of the Management Board of ECHA for the period from 1 June 2025 until 31 May 2029.
- 3. Against this background, it is recommended that <u>the Permanent Representatives Committee</u> invite <u>the Council</u>:
 - to adopt the Council Decision as set out in document ST 7210/25 (text revised by the legal/linguistic experts) as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings;
 - to agree this Decision to be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
