1. On 12 March 2025, the Council was notified by the Registrar of the Court of an application, pursuant Article 263 TFEU, for the partial annulment of Directive (EU) 2024/3019 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 November 2024 concerning urban wastewater treatment.
2. The Applicant invokes two pleas in law in support of its application:
  - i) infringement of the polluter-pays principle and the principle of equal treatment (prohibition of discrimination);
  - ii) infringement of the principle of proportionality.
3. According to Article 124 of the Rules of Procedure of the Court of Justice, the Council shall lodge a defence within two months of the notification of the application.
4. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed **DELETED**, **DELETED**, **DELETED** and **DELETED**, Legal Advisers of the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
