THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union, and in particular Article 29 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy,

Whereas:

- (1) On 17 March 2014, the Council adopted Decision 2014/145/CFSP ⁽¹⁾.
- (2) On 13 March 2023, the Council adopted Decision (CFSP) 2023/572 ⁽²⁾, hereby renewing the measures provided for in Decision 2014/145/CFSP for a further six months.
- (3) The Council received new information concerning certain persons subject to restrictive measures set out in the Annex to Decision 2014/145/CFSP. On the basis of the new information, the entries for 35 persons entries should be updated.
- (4) Decision 2014/145/CFSP should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The Annex to Decision 2014/145/CFSP is amended as set out in the Annex to this Decision.
