Statement by the Commission

"The Commission welcomes the agreement in Coreper on a draft negotiating mandate on its proposal to postpone the dates from which Member States are to apply certain requirements set out in the Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD) and in the Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive (CSDDD) ('Stop the Clock proposal').

The Commission welcomes the European Council conclusions of 20 March 2025 on competitiveness, European defence and security and migration, and, in particular, the call for co-legislators to adopt the proposal on the stop-the-clock mechanism on sustainability reporting and due diligence without delay and at the latest by June 2025.

The Stop the Clock proposal does not envisage to postpone the reporting obligations for 'wave one' companies, which are required to report for the first time in 2025 for financial year 2024.

To date, 11 Member States have not yet notified to the Commission the complete transposition of the CSRD. On 26 September 2024, those Member States received a Letter of Formal Notice for non-communication of their transposition measures. The deadline to reply was 26 November 2024.

No satisfactory transposition measures were put in place in these Member States, therefore on 24 March 2025 those Member States received a letter from Commissioner Albuquerque urging them to transpose the CSRD in a manner that ensures the reporting obligations for wave one companies are enforceable in their national legal systems, allowing them to comply with EU legislation by reporting in 2025 for the financial year 2024. The lack of complete transposition of the CSRD by some Member States creates legal uncertainty and an uneven playing field for businesses and investors in the Union, undermining the functioning of the Single Market and the objectives of the European Green Deal.

The Commission is also committed to exploring further options to address concerns about the uneven playing field during the negotiations of the proposal amending the Accounting Directive, the Audit Directive, the CSRD and the CSDDD as regards certain corporate sustainability reporting and due diligence requirements ('Content proposal'), to proposing swiftly a solution to address concerns related to the phasing in of additional ESRS data points for 'wave one' companies in 2026, via a quick-fix to the ESRS delegated act, and to working as quickly as possible on an overall revision of the ESRS delegated act and not later than 6 months after the entry into force of the revised CSRD."
