The SCA took note of the information provided by the Presidency on the outcome of the last trilogue held on 16 April and of the comments from delegations and the Commission.

The SCA exchanged views on green architecture on the basis of the Presidency's suggestions. The Presidency will take into account the outcome of this meeting for the continuation of the negotiations with the European Parliament.

The SCA noted that the CAP reform item at the Videoconference for Agriculture Ministers on 26 April would be a discussion item rather than an "other business" item.
