Subject:	Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the exchange of information between the law enforcement authorities of Member States and repealing Council Framework Decision 2006/960/JHA (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- On 8 December 2021 the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 87(2), point
  (a) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Data Protection Supervisor</u> delivered its opinion on 7 March 2022<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 18 May 2022<sup>3</sup>.
- 4. On 15 March 2023 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>4</sup>

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u><sup>5</sup> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 70/22, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Austria</u> and <u>Germany</u> abstaining.
- 6. The statement for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 7. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
