Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing a collaboration platform to support the functioning of joint investigation teams and amending Regulation (EU) 2018/1726 (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- On 1 December 2021 the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 82(1), point
  (d) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Data Protection Supervisor delivered its formal comments on 25 January 2022.
- On 30 March 2023 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>2</sup>.

- The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council<sup>3</sup></u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 73/22, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 5. The statement for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 6. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
