CURRICULUM VITAE

Gertrude TUMPEL-GUGERELL Vice Governor Oesterreichische Nationalbank

Gertrude Tumpel-Gugerell has served as Vice Governor of the Oesterreichische Nationalbank (OeNB), Austria's central bank, since 1998 and has been a Member of the Bank's Governing Board since 1997.

At the OeNB, Ms Tumpel-Gugerell is responsible for the Economics and Financial Markets Department. Moreover, she is Austria's Alternate Governor of the International Monetary Fund and member of the Economic and Finance Committee, which is the main economic policy advisory committee of the European Union.

Ms Tumpel-Gugerell chairs the Banking Advisory Committee (BAC) of the European Union. Current priorities of the BAC are giving advice to the European Commission on preparing and implementing the Basel II Accord and on integrating the accession countries into the work of the Committee.

As a member of the International Relations Committee of the ECB, she contributes to preparing common positions on international issues.

Ms Tumpel-Gugerell is also a member of the Banking Supervision Committee of the ECB and thus participates in the analytical work of, and exchange of views between, central bankers and supervisors on developments in banking and on financial stability issues. Moreover, she is a member of the advisory board of Austria's newly created Financial Market Authority (FMA).

Born on 11 November 1952 in Austria, Ms Tumpel-Gugerell graduated with honours and holds a doctorate degree in economics and social science from the University of Vienna (thesis on "Aspects of a Theory of Consumer Behaviour"). In 1975, she joined the Economics Division of Oesterreichische Nationalbank, initially being responsible for business cycle analysis.

From 1981 to 1984, Ms Tumpel-Gugerell served as Advisor in the Cabinet of the Minister of Finance. In this capacity, she negotiated inter alia the recapitalisation program for a major Austrian commercial bank. In 1984 she rejoined the OeNB as Deputy Head of the Economics Division.

From 1986 Ms Tumpel-Gugerell acted as the OeNB's Comptroller General, being responsible for strategic planning and auditing. In 1992, Ms Tumpel-Gugerell was promoted to the position of Director for Corporate Planning and Management. In this function she was inter alia in charge of coordinating the OeNB's preparations for participation in EMU.

Ms Tumpel-Gugerell has published on issues of economic policy, financial stability and regulation and has addressed the public in many speeches and presentations.

Beside her professional career at the central bank, she was a member of the founding council of Fachhochschulen (universities of applied sciences) in Austria in the early 1990s and was elected a member of the University Council of the University of Vienna in 2003.
