- At the meeting of the Working Party on Competitiveness and Growth (High Level) on 25 April 2024, the members of the group will discuss the topic of Innovation in the energyintensive industries ecosystem. During the working lunch, the members will exchange views on the topic of Financing landscape for industry.
- 2. The Chair of the group would like to invite a representative of European Trade Union Federation (ETUC) (transparency registry identification number: 06698681039-26) and a representative of European Chemical Industry Council (Cefic) (transparency registry identification number: 64879142323-90). They would present their views on the challenges the energy-intensive industries are facing, which will feed into the exchange of views between delegations on the topic of innovation in the energy-intensive industries ecosystem.
