# **STATEMENT 26/03**

# **Statement by the Commission**

"With reference to the Commission work programme for 2003, the Commission confirms its intention to present a proposal for a Directive addressing the implementation of the Aarhus Convention in respect of access to justice in environmental matters, which is envisaged for the first quarter of 2003."

### **STATEMENT 27/03**

### **Statement by the Greek delegation**

### Re Article 2:

"Greece considers that the deletion of point (g) of Article 6(3) of Directive 98/18/EC with effect from 1 January 2005 will have implications for the operation of domestic voyages between ports in Greek territory and for the activities of existing ships which will remain after that date in the Annex to Commission Decision 1999/461/EC of 24 June 1999.

In view of the political agreement on the deletion of the abovementioned point on 31 December 2005, reached in the Council on 17 June 2002 (10751/02 MAR 102 of 15 July 2002), Greece intends to submit to the Commission a request on the basis of the provisions of Directive 98/18/EC in order to enable the abovementioned ships to continue to operate on Greek domestic voyages until 31 December 2005."

### **STATEMENT 28/03**

### **Statement by the Commission**

"The Commission notes the declaration made by the Greek Government in relation to the implications that the deletion of point (g) of Article 6(3) with effect from 1 January 2005 may have for a very small number of ships among those appearing in the Commission

Decision 1999/461/EC <sup>1</sup> of 24 June 1999. The Commission notes the intention of the Greek Government to submit a request for a time-limited exemption of such ships from certain requirements of Directive 98/18/EC, in accordance with Article 7(3).

In the event of such notification, the Commission will examine it with the appropriate priority, taking into account the relevant provisions of Article 7(3) and (4) of Directive 98/18/EC."

### **STATEMENT 29/03**

### Statement by the Council and the Commission

"The Council and the Commission consider it to be of utmost importance that the International Convention on the Control of Harmful Anti-Fouling Systems on Ships (AFS Convention) is ratified and enters into force at the earliest possible opportunity, in order to ensure a global prohibition of the application of organotin compounds which act as biocides in anti-fouling systems on ships.

Recalling paragraph 33 of the Plan of Implementation agreed upon at the Johannesburg World Summit on Sustainable Development, the Council and the Commission consider that the adoption of the present Regulation may facilitate the early ratification and entry into force of the AFS Convention. The three-month period provided for between the entry into force and the application of the Regulation at EC level, at the latest on 1 July 2003, is to allow the putting into place of administrative means to implement it. During this period, it might be expected that a further number of countries will be able to ratify the AFS Convention. Even though the date of 1 January 2003 could not be upheld, owing to the procedures necessary for the adoption of the Regulation, the Council and the Commission stress the need to apply the prohibition at the earliest date possible."

# STATEMENT 30/03

# **Statement by the Council**

"The Council calls on the Commission to keep a constant watch on the use of aldicarb for essential purposes pursuant to Article 2(3), in particular on the basis of the data supplied under the last subparagraph of Article 2(3), and take any measures necessary by 2005."

### **STATEMENT 31/03**

# Statement by the United Kingdom, French, Portuguese, Spanish, Italian and Irish delegations on the non-inclusion of aldicarb in Annex I to Directive 91/414/EEC

"The United Kingdom, France, Portugal, Spain, Italy and Ireland note the non-inclusion of aldicarb in Annex I to Directive 91/414/EEC and the decision to allow aldicarb to be used for a number of essential purposes under strict controls.

Whilst supporting the aims of the EU pesticide review programme, to raise protection standards for workers, consumers and the environment, and noting the aims of the sixth environmental action programme in relation to pesticides, which refer to consistency with necessary crop protection, these delegations call on the Commission to take a more comprehensive approach to the assessment of plant protection products.

The United Kingdom, France, Portugal, Spain, Italy and Ireland are particularly concerned about the dwindling number of insecticides and the fact that very few replacement chemicals have been approved. These delegations believe that mechanisms need to be found in order to maintain a minimum number of compounds to sustain the production of key crops until better means of pest control can be developed. They believe that the current individual assessment of substances in isolation could eventually result in serious gaps in the plant protection armoury.

As one potential mechanism, the United Kingdom, France, Portugal, Spain, Italy and Ireland call on the Commission to consider a system of comparative assessment, at Member State/EU level, of plant protection product compounds, thus allowing for a more balanced and pragmatic approach to decisions on future compounds."

### **STATEMENT 32/03**

# **Statement by the German delegation**

"Germany supports the original Commission proposal of 17 December 2002 on the non-inclusion of aldicarb in Annex I to Directive 91/414/EEC and cannot therefore agree to the compromise proposal put forward.

Aldicarb does not satisfy the requirements of Directive 91/414/EEC, and this has long been recognised. Owing to the proven harmful effects on the environment, in particular the risk to groundwater, Germany has for many years refrained from using plant protection products containing this substance.

Substances the harmful effects of which have been demonstrated through EU testing should not be authorised for any "essential uses".

A decision on aldicarb in accordance with the compromise proposal could be regarded as a precedent for forthcoming decisions and would undermine the objective of harmonising the availability of plant protection products by 2008.

The granting of the transitional period provided for in the compromise proposal for substances which have long been "on hold" awaiting EU assessment and which are expected to have harmful effects on human and animal health, groundwater or the environment is contrary to the objectives of Directive 91/414/EEC."

### **STATEMENT 33/03**

### **Statement by the Commission re Article 2**

"This Directive aims at banning advertising, i.e. any form of communication designed to promote tobacco products through the press, radio and information society services.

This Directive respects the fundamental rights and observes the principles recognised in the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union, as recalled in recital 18 of the Directive, and in particular by Article 11 thereof and Article 10 of the European Convention on Human Rights. In this regard, this Directive does not in any way affect Sweden's right to apply its constitutional rules relating to freedom of the press and freedom of expression in the media."

### **STATEMENT 34/03**

### **Statement by the Commission re Article 3**

"The Commission will follow closely the implementation of this Directive. In particular, the Commission will verify whether the exceptions laid down in Article 3(1) of this Directive give rise to circumvention of the tobacco advertising ban provided for in the Directive. Should that be the case, the Commission will propose the necessary amendments to the Directive.

The Commission will also follow very closely the potential obstacles to the functioning of the internal market that may result from differences in Member States' legislation regarding sponsorship in or of the printed media and information society services, with a view to promoting tobacco products, and if necessary will propose the appropriate amendments to the Directive."

### STATEMENT 35/03

### **Statement by the Commission re Article 8**

"Subject to the Treaty, Member States retain the competence to regulate matters relating to tobacco advertising and sponsorship that fall outside the scope of this Directive, such as indirect advertising and sponsorship of events or activities without cross-border effect."

### **STATEMENT 36/03**

### **Statement by the Austrian delegation**

"Austria would point out that long-term agreements have been concluded, particularly in the field of sponsorship of events or activities organised worldwide. As no transitional period has been set for this specific form of sponsorship, the possibility of legal disputes cannot be excluded."
