With reference to my notification of 12 April 2018, I would hereby like to inform you that the Swedish Government on 3 May 2018 took the formal decision to reintroduce border control at the Swedish internal border until 11 November 2018.

The basis for the reintroduction and the scope of the control follow the lines given in the notification. Checks will initially take place at the same border sections and border crossing points as today.

Let me again assure you that I remain committed to the goal of returning to an area without internal border control as soon as the circumstances allow for this.
