Subject:	Proposal for a DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the minimum level of training of seafarers (codification) (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 18 November 2020 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal¹, based on Article 100(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 27 January 2021².
- 3. The <u>European Committee of the Regions</u> was consulted and decided not to issue an opinion.
- 4. On 5 April 2022, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council ³.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE- CONS 37/21, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 6. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
